With full knowledge and appreciation of the inherent risks associated with the Activities, Parent freely and voluntarily assumes on behalf of Child all such risks involved with participation in the Activities.

WAIVER/RELEASE/INDEMNIFICATION AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE: Parent voluntarily agrees to release from liability Family Worship Center Church, its owners, directors, officers, members, agents, employees, volunteers, representatives, assigns or others acting on their behalf (hereinafter collectively "FWCC") and hereby waives any and all rights Parent, Parent's heirs, representatives or assigns may have against FWCC to assert any cause of action, possible cause of action, claim or demand of any nature whatsoever, including but not limited to a claim for negligence or gross negligence which Parent, Parent's heirs, representatives or assigns may have now, or in the future, for personal injury or damage arising from Child's participation in the Activities, including but not limited to, the negligence, gross negligence, reckless or wanton conduct of FWCC or the conduct of any party connected in any way with FWCC.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Dear Parent,

Choice greetings in the name of Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior! Let me invite you to this year's International Kids Conference to be held on the campus of Family Worship Center Church in Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

The date of this year's camp is June 7-10. The cost is \$85, but if you pre-register before May 22, we offer a \$15 discount and guarantee your child an IKC t-shirt. The cost includes lunch and dinner for each full day of the conference; a conference ID badge, a lanyard (to keep as a souvenir), and access to all IKC activities. As stated on the registration form, this is a day conference; *no lodging is included*. Several hotels in the Baton Rouge area do offer discounts if you mention IKC when making your reservation. When you and your child initially arrive at the conference to check in, you will receive corresponding ID numbers. Parents, you must present this ID card to IKC staff in order for your child to be released.

International Kids Conference 2017 begins on Wednesday, June 7, at 7 p.m. in a joint service with Crossfire Youth Ministries. An ice cream social follows the Wednesday night service.

Thursday, June 8, through Saturday, June 10, all conference participants need to arrive no later than 9 a.m. and should be brought inside the main entrance lobby of Family Christian Academy. *All conference participants must be signed in each day by their parent or guardian.*

Conference events include a morning worship service at 10 a.m. and an evening worship service at 6 p.m. These services are comprised of a PowerPoint sermon, puppets, an offering, and time at the altars. Parents are welcome to attend with their children. Immediately following the close of the 6 p.m. service, parents need to come inside the Crossfire Auditorium and retrieve their children. During the conference, any child that needs to be picked up early must be signed out by his or her parent or guardian. Remember, you will be required to present the ID number card when signing out your child.

Medications:

Children are not allowed to keep medicine on their person. A staff nurse will be available throughout the conference to administer medicine to your child as needed under the following guidelines: All medication must be hand-delivered to the conference nurse DAILY and packaged in a Ziploc bag that includes the following:

- Child's name;
- Medicine and its label instructions;
- Name and number of an emergency contact;
- Symptoms or side effects to be aware of; and
- Detailed dosage instructions: amount/times/with or without food, etc.

Special Dietary Needs:

If your child cannot eat the food provided at the conference, you can bring meals in an insulated food container with his or her name on it and staff members will ensure your child receives it during designated meal times.

What To Bring:

Family Worship Center Church is not responsible for items lost or stolen during this conference, so please make sure that each of the following, including your child's backpack, is clearly marked with his or her name:

- A Bible, notebook, and pen;
- Backpack;
- Insect repellent (with high "DEET" protection);
- Sunscreen with high SPF protection;
- A change of clothes and an extra pair of shoes (in case of inclement weather);
- A beach-sized towel; and
- A poncho (in case of rain).

What To Wear:

Children attending this conference are required to dress appropriately and modestly. For water activities, girls are required to wear modest one-piece bathing suits, and boys are required to wear properly sized swimming trunks that tie at the waist. Both girls and boys are also required to wear a t-shirt over their swimwear.

What Not To Bring:

- Cell phones;
- Radios;
- CD players;
- Electronic games and devices;
- Toys;
- Board games;
- Cards;
- Books or magazines;
- Any type of knife or other item that could be perceived or used as a weapon; and
- Any item that is irreplaceable or of great personal value.
