- I consider what I’m about to say to be the most important thing on the face of the earth. I am speaking about world evangelism—the taking of the gospel to every person in every home in the world.



- Consider what I say as it regards your faithfulness respecting this work for God. Are you doing all that you can do? I know that many of you are, but I also know that many of you aren’t.


- Consider what I say because one day all of us will stand before the Lord, and we will give account for our participation in this that the Lord has called us to do. Consider what I say!
