

The Conspiracy Part I

FROM THE BOOK, JOSEPH, BY JIMMY SWAGGART

"And a certain man found him (found Joseph), and, behold, he was wandering in the field: and the man asked him, saying, What do you seek? And he said, I seek my brethren: tell me, I pray you, where they feed their flocks. And the man said, They are departed from here; for I heard them say, Let us go to Dothan. And Joseph went after his brethren, and found them in Dothan. And when they saw him afar off, even before he came near unto them, they conspired against him to kill him." -GENESIS 37:15-18

LITTLE DID JACOB realize that his sending Joseph to his brothers would instigate a time of sorrow of unparalleled proportions. It would break his heart to such an extent that, in fact, there are no words that could adequately describe, at least properly, what Joseph's brothers did to him and, thereby, to their aged father Jacob.

Such is sin. It has no heart. It truly steals, kills, and destroys.

The sons of Jacob were guilty of murder, for their hatred fostered such. The Scripture plainly says that *"whosoever hates his brother is a murderer"* (I John 3:15), and this even though the deed itself may not be carried out.

The sons of Jacob hated their brother because their father loved him. Joseph was a type of Christ, for though He was the beloved Son of His Father and hated by a wicked world, yet the Father sent Him out of His bosom to visit us in great humility and love. He came from Heaven to earth to seek and save us, and that despite our hatred toward Him.

Christ In The Actions Of Joseph

He came to His own, and His own not only received Him not, but consulted saying, "This is the Heir, come, let us kill Him; crucify Him, crucify Him!" This He submitted to in pursuance of His design to redeem and save us.

As we go forward in this narrative, we will see Christ in the actions of Joseph set out perfectly before us. As such, we must learn what the Holy Spirit is telling us through the life of this man.

have to walk more than 60 miles to find his brothers.

Even before he arrived there, that is, when they saw him coming, they conspired to kill him. It was thus so with Christ as well. When He was born, Herod sought to kill Him (Matt. 2).

Shechem?

If it is to be remembered, Shechem is the place where Simeon and Levi killed all the men of that small town because their sister Dinah had been raped.

Some period of time had now passed, but the greater reason that the brothers were not fearful of reprisal is probably due to their great strength.

That Jacob would have to send a part of his herds so far away as to Shechem — a distance of some fifty miles or more — tells us how large these herds were and, therefore, the power of Jacob. There is a possibility that there was quite a number of other men with the brothers at that time and, no doubt, were actually serving in their employ, which would have made this group powerful indeed.

Reuben

"And they said one to another, Behold, this dreamer comes. Come now therefore, and let us kill him, and cast him into some pit, and we will say, Some evil beast has devoured him: and we shall see what will become of his dreams. And Reuben heard it, and he delivered him out of their hands; and said, Let us not kill him. And Reuben said unto them, Shed no blood, but cast him into this pit that is in the wilderness, and lay no hand upon him; that he might rid him out of their hands, to deliver him to his father again" (Gen. 37:19-22).


Partly through the personal character of Joseph, partly through the evil passions of his brethren, partly through the apparently casual incidents of the neighborhood, partly through the Spirit of righteousness working in the heart of Reuben, and partly through the weakness and fondness of Jacob, we see all things working together in God's hands! He wove the web composed of many single threads into one united, orderly pattern as a whole in which we are able to trace His own thought and purpose.

When we look at Joseph in the pit and in the prison, and look at him afterward as ruler over all the land of Egypt, we see the difference between the thoughts of God and the thoughts of men. So, when we look at the Cross and at the throne of the Majesty in the heavens, we see the same thing.

Nothing ever brought out the real state of man's heart toward God but the coming of Christ.

Conscience

Reuben was actually the firstborn; consequently, it was to him that the birthright should have gone. This would have guaranteed him a double portion of Jacob's riches when the patriarch came down to die. So, he would have had the most to gain from Joseph's death, who, by now, had been given the birthright *Continued on page 8*

instead. However, Reuben seemed to have some conscience left, where his brethren did not. As such, the Scripture says, "*He delivered him out of their hands; and said*, *Let us not kill him.*"

Several things greatly rankled these men.

The dreams angered them greatly, as did the coat of many colors. So, they would kill the one who dreamed the dreams and strip the coat from him, thinking to silence his voice. Little did they know what the future held!

Reuben suggested that they put Joseph in a pit, which they did, with him thinking that he would come back later and rescue the boy. Evidently he had to go some place. When he returned, he found that Joseph was gone. They had sold him to the Ishmaelites.

Along with Reuben, Judah was the one

who saved the life of Joseph, suggesting that they sell him as a slave. However, this was little an act of mercy on the part of Judah inasmuch as under normal circumstances, they were consigning him to a life worse than death.

Twenty Pieces Of Silver

"And it came to pass, when Joseph was come unto his brethren, that they stripped Joseph out of his coat, his coat of many colors that was on him; And they took him, and cast him into a pit: and the pit was empty, there was no water in it. And they sat down to eat bread: and they lifted up their eyes and looked, and, behold, a company of Ishmaelites came from Gilead with their camels bearing spicery and balm and myrrh, going to carry it down to Egypt. And Judah said unto his brethren, What profit is it if we kill our brother, and conceal his blood? Come, and let us sell him to the Ishmaelites, and let not our hand be upon him: for he is our brother and our flesh. And his brethren were content. Then there passed by Midianites merchantmen; and they drew and lifted up Joseph out of the pit, and sold Joseph to the Ishmaelites for twenty pieces of silver: and they brought Joseph into Egypt" (Gen. 37:23-28).

The merchants who bought Joseph were called both Midianites and Ishmaelites. They were sons of Abraham by Hagar and Keturah, making them kin in some distant way to the Israelites.

These brothers sitting down to eat bread, even after they had thrown Joseph into the pit, shows how hard their hearts were, indicating deplorable brutality on their part. In their minds, they had satisfactorily disposed of the young man and his dreams. This coat of colors, which signified that he had now been chosen for the birthright instead of Reuben, would be used to deceive his father.

Evidently, when they put him in the pit, their idea was to let him starve to death, but now, a change of events came about in that they spotted a camel train coming near them and going down to Egypt. They would sell Joseph as a slave to these Ishmaelites and make some profit from the transaction. Judah was the one who suggested this. They would get twenty pieces of silver. This is a type of Christ being sold for thirty pieces of silver.

As they stripped the coat from Joseph, likewise, they cast lots for Jesus' robe. **#**



Q&A with Sister Swaggart

Q. Is God really merciful to people?

A. Yes. In fact, the Lord proclaims Himself as merciful. In Exodus 34, Moses stands in the cleft of the rock, exactly where the Lord told him to stand. *"And the Lord passed by before him, and proclaimed, The Lord, The Lord God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth"* (Ex. 34:6). How grateful we are that the first word God uses here to describe Himself is merciful.

The Lord Himself lays down the rules as to how and to whom mercy is shown. The last thing any person wants to do is demand justice from God. We want mercy and compassion, but we must understand that none is due us, and the moment we think so is the moment we nullify these attributes. Romans 9:16 says, "So then it is not of him that willeth, nor of him that runneth, but of God that sheweth mercy."

One receives mercy and compassion from God by admitting that he does not deserve any, but rather the very opposite. He does not present to God any of his socalled accomplishments or qualities. Remember the publican who Jesus said stood afar off and *"would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner"* (Luke 18:13).

In God's dealings with man, He purposely chose grace as His vehicle of communication. Grace has to be a choice, or it is not grace. However, once grace was chosen, then mercy—a natural product of grace—became a guarantee.

Sometimes, believers feel they are not being treated fairly by the Lord when, in reality, if we received what we justly deserved, our situation would be far worse. Irrespective of our failures, His dealings with us are always with mercy and compassion, which means that we are not chastised as severely as we ought to be. David said, *"He hath not dealt with us after our sins; nor rewarded us according to our* *iniquities.* For as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is his mercy toward them who fear him" (Ps. 103:10-11).

The genesis of salvation is declared to be in two of God's attributes, the first being mercy, or compassion. God has a tender yearning toward men who are brought to misery by their own sins. His mercy is immeasurable and endures forever:

• "It is of the LORD's mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. "They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness" (Lam. 3:22-23).

• *"Gracious is the LORD, and righteous; yea, our God is merciful."* (Ps. 116:5)

• "O give thanks unto the God of heaven: for his mercy endureth for ever" (Ps. 136:26).

• "But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us" (Eph. 2:4).

We have believers today demanding justice instead of asking for mercy. Why is that? None of us deserve the mercy of God, but all of us—from kings to blind beggars—need it.

Psalm 51 opens with David's repentant plea: "Have mercy upon me, O God, according to thy lovingkindness: according unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot out my transgressions."

Bible scholar Albert Barnes says of this verse: "Have mercy upon me, O God" is the utterance of a full heart; a heart crushed and broken by the consciousness of sin. The psalmist had been made to see his great guilt; and his first act is to cry out for mercy. The only hope of a sinner when crushed with the consciousness of sin is the mercy of God; and the plea for that mercy will be urged in the most earnest and impassioned language that the mind can employ."

Mercy was central to the prophecy Zacharias utters in Luke 1 regarding the Messiah: "To perform the mercy promised to our fathers, and to remember his holy covenant" (Luke 1:72). From that same passage: "Through the tender mercy of our God; whereby the dayspring from on high hath visited us" (Luke 1:78). This reveals that the sending of Jesus Christ, God's only Son, was strictly an act of mercy, and tender mercy at that.

That's why, when he heard that Jesus of Nazareth was passing by, blind Bartimaeus cried out, "Jesus, thou Son of David, have mercy on me" (Luke 18:38). He asked because he had heard that Jesus was merciful, and Bartimaeus knew that Christ placed no distinction between rich or poor, old or young, beautiful or beggar.

In Matthew 9:27, two blind men followed Jesus crying out after Him, "*Thou Son of David, have mercy on us.*" That simple statement—have mercy on us—is a request the Lord will always answer.

Men do not need justice, they need mercy. The writer of Hebrews tells us, "*Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need*" (Heb. 4:16). This means that God strongly desires to show mercy and grace to all who come to Him. As someone has said, "Mercy is God's disposition toward sinful men, but love is His motive in all that He does for them."

The mercy of God is really beyond our comprehension because it is new every morning, always before us, and also behind us, following the believer all the days of his life (Ps. 23:6). All we can do is praise Him and thank Him for it.

"I will sing of the mercies of the LORD for ever: with my mouth will I make known thy faithfulness to all generations" (Ps. 89:1).

THE LORD WILL DO Great Things

MANY OF US were alarmed at the outcome of the 2020 U.S. presidential election and, as of this writing (Jan. 26, 2021), we all thought we would be free from the draconian lockdown measures. Alas, it appears that it will continue further into 2021. However, as believers, our focus should not be on COVID, Washington blunders, lockdowns, or businesses being partially open. Instead, we should look to the Lord, for the Lord can and will move on behalf of His children regardless of external circumstances.

The book of Joel is referred to by Pentecostals as the Holy Spirit book of the Old Testament. It was in this book that Joel spoke of the coming outpouring of the Holy Spirt, a prophecy Peter would quote on the day of Pentecost.

The name Joel means "Jehovah is God," and that is something we should never forget. In times of crisis, like the ones we now face, it's easy for some believers to forget that Jesus Christ is God, and He is in charge, not man.

The prophecy of Joel is undated; it is general. It covers the period of the "times

of the Gentiles," meaning from the time of Nebuchadnezzar to the time of the anti-Christ. The message was directed to Judah.

The prediction of the prophecy concerns the blessings that are to come upon God's people during the coming kingdom age because it concerns the future. Too many Christians believe these blessings are unavailable now. But if the Holy Spirit allowed Peter to claim its promises on the day of Pentecost, then the Lord allows us to claim these great promises right now.

The church has a problem of looking to the past or to the future, but not the present. The church must always remember that we serve a "now" God. We have a better covenant based on better promises.

The book of Hebrews tells us:

1. Christ is better than the angels.

2. The new covenant contains a better hope.

3. Jesus is the mediator of a better covenant.

4. The new covenant is established upon better promises.

5. Our Lord offered a better sacrifice.

6. God has provided better things for us.

7. Jesus speaks better things than that of Abel.

So let's look at what the Lord told Joel, and what He is telling us.

Fear Not

Satan may be powerful, but Jesus Christ is all powerful. He is the "I Am" of the "I Will," and His Word is "fear not." II Timothy 1:7 says: "God hath not given us a spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind." Multiple times in the Gospels we read the words of Christ to His disciples: "fear not." Don't let fear rule your life. Don't let fear keep you in your house, afraid of a man-made health crisis. Yes, bad things happen in the world, but don't become a slave to the fears of what *might* happen.

Be Glad And Rejoice

Put on the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness. Isaiah 61:3 says: "To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness; the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified." Shake off those heavy bands, lift up holy hands and begin to be glad and rejoice in the Lord.

For The Lord Will Do Great Things

God can do great things for those who will believe Him and not allow fear to rule and reign. Believe God for big things. He is a big God, so ask big. In the midst of a hostile government and a man-made virus, God can and will still do great things.

Restoration

Then the "I Am" of the "I Will" said He would do this for us: "I will restore to you the years that the locust hath eaten, the cankerworm, and the caterpillar and the palmerworm."

Harvest

"The floors shall be full of wheat." This is used to symbolize the coming harvest of souls that will be brought into the kingdom. *"The fats* (vats) *shall overflow with wine and oil."* This speaks of a superabundant flow of the Holy Spirit, which wine and oil are symbols of.

Plenty

"Ye shall eat in plenty, and be satisfied." In Psalm 37:25, David said: "I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging "I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread." Psalm 37:25

bread." Just make sure your steps are ordered by the Lord (Ps. 37:23). The Lord desires His children to have plenty and be satisfied. As said in Philippians 4:19: "*But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.*"

"Ye shall ... praise the name of the LORD your God that hath dealt wondrously with you."

We should be praising the Lord continuously, no matter what is happening in the world. "*My people shall never be ashamed.*" What a promise!

The Fruit of Sin and Righteousness

"But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life." –ROMANS 6:22



Holiness

Holiness is simply living a holy life; it is the total opposite of iniquity. This direction Paul gives is the same principle as before in previous verses, but now it's going in the opposite direction. Instead of iniquity leading to iniquity and dragging someone down, now, due to the cross of Christ, that person is going upward. I want you to understand that. Instead of going downward, which is where sin leads, you are now heading ever upward. Upward because of Christ. Upward because of the cross. Upward because of faith. As a result of this change, the power of the indwelling sin nature has been broken, and we no longer yield our members toward unrighteousness, but now we can yield them to righteousness unto holiness, and the only requirement is that we follow Christ.

Being A Servant Of God

Another aspect of living for the Lord is that the individual becomes a servant of God. I know that most would look at this term in a negative way, but when it comes to being a Christian, it becomes such a privilege to be known as a servant of God. The word *servant* speaks of being a slave, but not in a negative way. If you look in the Old Testament, when a slave was given his freedom but declined it to stay "Instead of going downward, which is where sin leads, you are now heading ever upward. Upward because of Christ. Upward because of the cross. Upward because of faith." where he was, he did so for a specific reason. He did it because he loved his master who granted him protection, safety, and security. He was treated so well that he felt he would have more freedom serving his master than living outside of that particular home. To mark his decision to stay, such a servant would take an aul and pierce his ear, indicating his intention to remain there forever.

How much better do we have it now? Paul said we have a better covenant based on better promises. We have protection, safety, and security in Christ. We will have more freedom living for Christ than not, and we do it because of His love for us and our love for Him. I would much rather be known as a servant of God than a servant of the Devil. As they say, our worst day serving the Lord is ten thousand times better than a lifetime with the Devil.

Being Made Free From Sin

This is something that we need to understand, and I speak of living a victorious life in Christ. Every believer has the potential to live this more abundant life, but so many fail to avail themselves of experiencing this more abundant life, and the reason is a lack of knowledge of the cross.

There is only one cure for the sinner and the saint—Christ and Him crucified. What He did for us was for the entirety of the world, for with His death on Calvary's cross, the sin debt was removed. But thank the Lord that this great blessing did not stop there, for not only did it remove the sin debt for those would simply believe, but it also broke the grip of sin in the life of the believer. This means that if we look to the cross daily—place our faith in Christ and Him crucified—we can be continually made free from the sin nature. In Romans 6:14 Paul said, *"sin shall not have dominion over you,*" which means exactly what it says: you can be free now, and you can be made free, daily, from the grip of sin that has plagued your life. However, we can experience this only if we take advantage of God's prescribed order of victory—the cross.

Everlasting Life

Living for the Lord will lead to everlasting life. Paul concluded Romans 6 by saying, *"For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life, through Jesus Christ our Lord."* The answer for the sin problem in the world and in the church is the same—Jesus Christ and Him crucified. We must begin this salvation life at the cross, and we must never leave the cross because it brings life and life ever more abundant. ***







STORIES, SCRIPTURES AND THOUGHTS ABOUT HEAVEN

"Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me. In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may **be also.**" –JOHN 14:1-3



The spiritual atmosphere of the new heaven and the new earth will be awesome. Relationships among all the redeemed will be perfect. Never a squabble with anyone. Not even an angelic being. Scripture says there will not be marriage relationships, but we will have and show agape love to everyone (Matt. 22:30). The agape love you have for your spouse here on earth will be enlarged a thousand times for your spouse and for everyone vou meet.

Our sin nature will be gone. The issues Saint Paul wrote about in Romans 6, 7, and 8 will be over. Sin and temptation will be behind us. By this time, Satan and his demonic followers will be in the lake of fire. The Tempter is removed. The sin nature is purged from our being. We won't have to deal with Adam's fall in the new heaven.

Scripture is clear as to who will be in heaven and who will not be there. There will be three categories of persons in heaven:


- The divine trinity—Father, Son and Holy Spirit
- The holy angels of God
- The redeemed of all ages

Satan and his demons will not be in heaven but in the lake of fire.

If your name is not written in the Lamb's Book of Life, you won't be in heaven (Rev. 20:15, 21:27). You can be the most respected church member in your city and still not be admitted to heaven. You can give millions of dollars to the poor and still not be allowed in heaven. It is simple; Jesus, our Lord, said you must be born again (John 3:3). The Apostle Paul declared that you must believe and confess that Christ is Lord (Rom. 10:9-10). Saint Peter said on the day of Pentecost that you must repent (Acts 2:38). The occupants of heaven are blood-washed (I Cor. 6:11, Rev. 1:5, 7:14) and sanctified (I Cor. 1:2, 6:11, Heb. 10:10, Jude 1:1).

I hope to see my father and mother there. I hope to see my six sisters and seven brothers there. I hope to see hundreds, maybe thousands, of former church members and former students and ministerial colleagues and church leaders there. Friend, I hope you will be there. I really hope to see Enoch, Noah, Abraham, Joseph, Moses, Caleb, Samuel, David, Josiah, Elijah, Jeremiah, Paul, Peter, John, Barnabas, and Luke. I hope to visit with Gabriel, Michael, and many more angels. I am excited about attending the marriage supper of the Lamb. What an event that will be (Rev. 19:7-9).

Most of all, I want to see Jesus! Jesus, the lowly Nazarene, the Lamb of God, and now the King of kings. Wow, what a day, what



a glorious day that will be! In Revelation 22:4, Scripture says that we will be able to see His face. Can you imagine what it will be like when you look into His eyes, to see the sparkle of His eyes, the glow upon His face, the smile upon His lips? I do want to feel the nail prints in His hands. I want to hear Him say, *"Enter thou into the joy of thy Lord"* (Matt. 25:21). At that moment, I may fall at His feet, jump for joy, or weep like a baby. I don't know, but it will be the greatest moment of my life. Esther L. Kerr Rusthoi wrote the song, *"When We See Christ." The chorus says:*

In respect to activities in heaven, Scripture does refer to the judgment seat of Christ for all believers and the marriage supper of the Lamb. 1. We will be allowed plenty of time to fellowship with one another.

2. We will be involved in gigantic praise and worship experiences.

3. We will enjoy hearing the teaching of truth from the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

4. There will be times and sessions to hear testimonials from the redeemed of the Lord.

5. We may be given administrative assignments to serve others in the eternal age. **#**

SEASONS OF change

"To every thing there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven." –ECCLESIASTES 3:1

The Truth About Seasons

Ecclesiastes tells us that there is a time for everything. One of the truths that the Bible declares is that as long as the earth exists, seasons will continue. These seasons are regarded as needful by God, and they accomplish certain things in nature that help provide for the earth's well-being.

It seems that human beings are often slated for a journey through different seasons as well. While many changes are hurtful, or seemingly so, the changes we experience can oftentimes lead us to something new, even something far better—something that God has set into motion for us.

If you find yourself in a season of change, or you recognize one of the seasons that I am about to describe, don't be alarmed. The Season Of Summer

Summer is most people's favorite time of the year. Growing up, summer included a magical time of warmth, sun, swimming, water skiing, fishing, sleeping late, and long car rides to visit relatives. We spent time climbing in the mountains and staying up until the stars came out. The weather was absolutely marvelous. It was pleasantly warm. The trees stood in the height of their glory. The grass was a bright green and hay waved at you from the meadow. Summer is the season where everything is going your way. The job is what you want it to be. The children are behaving. But of this I am overwhelmingly convinced: God is faithful, and if He has me in winter, then He has also prepared for me a moment in time for spring. Soon after spring will come the relief and reassurance of another summer.

Seasons exist in our lives because God sees something about our lives that needs to die in order to produce something new and life-giving, something beneficial for His kingdom and our lives. Make no mistake about it, life is seasonal. There won't be just one go-round of seasonal change. Change is sure to happen again and again and again. If we will but look to Christ and trust in His marvelous grace to supply us with what we need in every season, we will discover Him to be the ever faithful one. He is an ever merciful and kind God. Hebraic Roots Movement

PART

The most subtle, yet frightening issue of the Hebraic Roots Movement (HRM) is its attraction to Jewish mysticism. The lure they are using to attract Christians and newly converted Jews is sentimentally toward Israel and everything Jewish. Because Jewish and liberal Christian communities agree that the Bible canon can be perpetually interpreted they will accept a variety of interpretations as inspired.

Deception

The process of deception always leads one to look at self instead of God. The extra-biblical writings associated with HRM such as the Midrash and Talmud focus on the reader and his personal struggle to reach an acceptable moral application of the text. The reader becomes drawn to use his inner struggles and personal experience to interpret Scripture and, thereby, becomes susceptible to others defining Scripture by experience. Personal reflection replaces biblical text while mystical insight is given to unsuspecting believers.

More Deception

The HRM has different levels and depths of belief. Similar to the Word of Faith teachers, HRM teachers embrace different aspects of their movement for their own benefit. For example, there's a wellknown ministry that has committed itself to being a friend of Israel. The efforts of Christians United For Israel are limited to political support and good deeds toward Jews. Evangelization of Jews is prohibited. In another popular ministry, the emphasis is on esoteric explanations of the Bible with Talmudic comprehension. Only the teacher has this deep insight.

The Zohar?

The HRM tries to define God through seeking a deeper meaning of creation. This prominent concept is derived from the Cabala (Kabbala) and its teachings of Jewish mysticism, which have gained acceptability and has aroused the curiosity of Hollywood stars. Cabala's roots can be found in Hellenistic (Greek) astral mysticism. Adherents, through meditation and the use of magic formulas, journey through and beyond the seven astral spheres; "the astral world takes on the form projected by man's consciousness."

According to the Zohar, the preeminent book of Cabala from which Rabbis are said to have developed from the Talmud, as documented in Webster's Secret Societies and also in the Jewish Encyclopedia, the "Mysteries of Wisdom" were imparted to Adam while he was still in the garden of Eden, in the form of a book delivered by the angel, Razael. From Adam, the book passed on to Seth, Enoch, Noah, and Abraham, with Moses receiving it for the first time on Mount Sinai. Then it was passed to the seventy elders, to David, Solomon, Ezra, Nehemiah, and then to the rabbis of the early Christian era, etc. It was viewed as only oral tradition until it was written down by the disciples of Simon ben Jochai.

The story of Simon ben Jochai is found in the Talmud. He and his son concealed themselves in a cave for twelve years and were sitting in sand up to their necks as they meditated on the sacred laws. Tradition says they were frequently visited by Elijah. The secrets were then written by Simon ben Jochai's son, Eliezer, and his secretary, Rabbi Abba.

New Age Teaching

According to the Zohar, God is the unknowable and immutable En Sof (Infinite). The Ten Sefirot (realms or planes) are the symbols of the inner life and processes of the Godhead in Zoharic theosophy; these are the foundations to the New Age movement as well-many paths to God. They are also believed to be the archetypes for everything in the world of creation, "understanding their workings can illuminate the inner workings of the cosmos and history." Are you beginning to see the philosophical connections to the Word of Faith and New Age teachings and Jewish and Roman Catholic mysticism? It is also a big part of Islamic mysticism—Sufism.

False Prophets

Is there some hidden mystical or esoteric knowledge that is yet to be discovered that may be the catalyst to uniting all faiths? Is there something outside of historic Christianity and Judaism that could bring them into common ground with Islam?

Yes! To those who are deceived. And this is where the danger of the HRM and liberal Christianity is heading. Matthew 24:24 says, *"For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect."*

Islam

For example, according to Islamic tradition, the Mahdi will find lost portions of the Old Testament and New Testament. Some believe he may even find the ark of the covenant, and through these finds, he will argue with Christians and Jews, and win some over to Islam.

According to one Islamic scholar, Ka'b al-Ahbar, "He will be called Mahdi because he will guide to something hidden and will bring out Torah and gospel from a town called Antioch." Another Muslim scholar says, "He will bring out volumes of the Torah to refute the Jews. At the hand of the Mahdi, the ark of the covenant will be brought forth from the lake of Tiberius and taken and placed in Jerusalem." Other Muslim scholars mention the new inspired findings will come out of Syria. Is it possible that HRM adherents and liberal Christians may be susceptible to a future "new" discovery?

Test The Spirits

Although Solomon said, "there is nothing new under the sun," mysticism has a unique uniting factor that can quietly deceive through similar experiences attained by devotees of all faiths.

The simple test for a false prophet is to apply I John 4:1-3: "Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world. Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God: And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world."


The incarnation of our Lord was for the purpose of Him coming to the world to be Savior. He accomplished this through His death on the cross, alone! It is exclusively His redemption, and we can only participate by believing. Islam does not believe. Judaism does not believe. The Roman Catholic church does not believe because it adds their tradition, which makes the Word of God of none effect. Liberal Christianity no longer exclusively believes in the finished work of the cross. What do you believe? How you answer this question will determine your eternal destination.

I BELIEVE IN NOTHING

Faith is essential for a proper relationship with God. Without faith, it is impossible to please God (Heb. 11:6). Jesus' own disciples, in the very midst of walking beside the Son of God, asked Him for more faith. Children of God have experienced miracles, been set free from sin, and grown in their relationship with God as a result of exercising their faith. Yet not everybody believes in God. No, there are those who have no desire to please God. Instead, they arrogantly proclaim, "I believe in nothing."



"There Is No Creator"

Atheists declare with prideful yet unsubstantiated confidence that there is no Creator. They would have us believe that everything came out of nothing—the stars, the planets, the sun, and the moon came out of nothing. They propose that our own Planet Earth did not come into existence as a result of a divine decree but evolved over a vast amount of time. For them, everything came out of nothing. They literally believe in nothing.

Do They Really Believe In Nothing?

No, of course not. It takes more faith to believe in evolution than it does in the biblical account of creation. They would have us believe that somehow, in the distant past, the spark of life was produced when there was an electrical reaction between two molecules that just happened to bump into each other in the vast distance of nothingness. From this came all that we see around us. The obvious question needs to be asked, Where did the first two molecules come from? Matter cannot be created in a vacuum. The first law of thermodynamics states that you can convert energy into matter, but even the best scientists cannot create something out of nothing. To convert energy, it must first exist in one form or another. The law of conservation of mass says, "Matter can change form through physical or chemical changes. The same amount of matter exists before and after the change-none is created or destroyed." That being the case, where did the first two molecules come from? It seems to me that it takes more faith to believe in evolution (dev*il*ution) than in a Creator.

"There Is No One To Help"


They proclaim that there is no one looking over us. There is no one you can turn to who can help you. If it is to happen, then you have to do it. When it comes to a higher power, they believe there is nothing or no one to place your faith in. Atheism sees man as the only and logical solution to man's problems. Humanistic psychology teaches that man will progressively improve until all of man's problems will be solved through man's efforts. We will then experience a man-made utopia. Really? So far, man's record is not good. The evidence shows that wickedness is on the increase. An apple left on the table for weeks does not improve but decays. Man cannot improve without God. He needs to be born again.

"They Are Without Excuse"

Paul addressed those who refused God in his day. "For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness; Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed it unto them. For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse: Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened. Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools" (Rom 1:18-22).

The splendor of creation points to the existence of God. The inner voice of the Holy Spirit speaks to them of the existence of God. Yet they choose to reject the revelation of God. It's not that they don't believe there is a God, but they know if they admit there is a God, then they have to admit their need of God. They have to admit that their lifestyle goes contrary to the edicts of a holy God. Instead of embracing a loving God's solution to sin, they would rather embrace the sin itself. They would rather declare that they believe in nothing.

Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted." –ISAIAH 53:3-4

DEPRESSION FROM GUILT

PART IV In previous articles, we covered how, spiritually, depression can be caused by hopelessness, lack of purpose, and

grief. This article focuses on one more cause of depression: guilt.

Guilt is the fact of falling short of God's standards because of sin (Rom. 3:23), and not just a feeling. In the Bible, there are three kinds of guilt: condemnation, conviction (godly sorrow), and the sorrow of the world, which is only being sorry about getting caught and having to face consequences (II Cor. 7:10).

Condemnation is not only deciding that someone is guilty of doing something wrong and deserves punishment, it also judges the motives of the heart and eternal destiny of a person, and imposes the sentence. Conviction, on the other hand, comes from God when the Holy Spirit reproves of sin, righteousness, and judgment (John 16:7-11).

The Bible says the following are some results of guilt:

• Fear of judgment, hiding, and blaming others (Gen. 3:7-13)

• Shame (Prov. 13:5)

• Distress, trouble, and a broken heart (Lam. 1:20)

• No rest or peace (Isa. 57:20)

• Confusion (Jer. 7:19)

• Physical, spiritual, and eternal death (Rom. 6:23)

- Envy, strife, and divisions (I Cor. 3:3)
- Grief (Ps. 31:10)
- Fear (Mic. 7:17)

One of the greatest descriptions of the physical and emotional results of guilt are found in Psalm 38:

• God's hand (strength and power) presses me sore (Ps. 38:2).

• There is no soundness (wholeness or soundness) in my flesh. Neither is there any rest (peace, or tranquility in my bones) (Ps. 38:3).

• My sins are a burden (load, to be lifted, to carry or bear) too heavy (burdensome, multiplied) for me (Ps. 38:4).

• I am troubled (my mind is rent, twisted, disturbed, and distorted). I am greatly bowed down (caused to stoop, crouch, sink low, subdued, in humility, and servitude). I go mourning all the day long (with darkness, sadness, and gloom) (Ps. 38:6).

• I am feeble (stunned, paralyzed, astonished, and weakened). Sore broken (crushed, broken in pieces, contrite, humbled, weighed down by guilt, judgment). Roared (crying out) by disquietness of heart (agitation, threat of despairing of hope) (Ps. 38:8).

• Groaning (moaning, and sighing because of physical, spiritual, and mental despair) (Ps. 38:9).

• Heart panting (goes back and forth,

wanders, and throbs). My strength (power) fails me (leaves, forsakes, and abandons because of being defeated resulting in sickliness, leanness, and gauntness). Light of my eyes is gone from me (so I cannot see) (Ps. 38:10).

• My foot slips (is removed or falling causing to waver, wobble, instability, stumbling, and falling) (Ps. 38:16),

• I am ready to halt (to give up and quit). Sorrow (pain, suffering, and grief) is continually before me (Ps. 38:17).

• I will be sorry (uneasy, anxious, and fearful) for my sin (Ps. 38:18).

People do a lot of things to avoid guilt. They try to change or modify the Bible, blame their circumstances, or redefine sins as diseases or bad habits. These are attempts to either decrease

or remove the need of dealing with problems as sin, but none of these are successful since there is only one answer and solution for sin. For the unsaved person, the only answer for guilt is to get saved, and for the believer, it is to repent and ask for forgiveness (I John 1:9). Both are possible only because of Jesus dying on the cross.

When a person gets saved by confessing and repenting of his sin, and through faith, receives Jesus Christ as his personal Savior and Lord, his sins are forgiven and guilt is removed. This means that the justice of God is satisfied for his sins because of Christ's death on the cross, he is at peace with God (Eph. 2:14-17, Col. 1:20-22), and reconciled to a right relationship with God (Rom. 5:10; II Cor. 5:18-19).

Not only is the penalty, or punishment, cancelled, but the sin, which is an offense to the holiness of God, is also removed. So both the sins (Ps. 78:38; 79:9; Lev. 5:18), and the sinner (Lev. 4:20) are atoned for. This is the only way that guilt, which can lead to depression, can be removed.






