Childhood LOST Part III

From Rape Of A Nation By Jimmy Swaggart

Changing Patterns We offer no easy solution. A vast multitude of social and cultural changes over the last several decades have seriously weakened the potential of the home for instilling values in children. The sexual revolution of the 1960s, a skyrocketing divorce rate, changes in women's economic and social status, modern child-rearing methods, and legislation that interferes in parent-child relationships all contribute to the altered nature of childhood.

There is even today at least one organization promoting the child-free life — a condition that is becoming more and more acceptable in today's society.15

There is also an ever-increasing number of adult-centered homes — as opposed to the traditional child-centered home. At one time, almost all homes were child-oriented. At the turn of the century, there were very few singles in society, and the majority of parents didn't survive long after their youngest child left home. This is no longer the case.

What has been called "the graying of

America" is a result of medical advancements and longer life spans. Hence, the population of the elderly is increasing, and political power (and thus social power) is rapidly shifting from the young to the middle-aged — and even to the elderly. While it is right and necessary that our older citizens receive attention, the focus away from children can produce unfortunate results. It's always the weakest political group that ends up neglected within a nation, and children are rapidly becoming one of our smallest population segments.

The rapidly disappearing division between childhood and adulthood breaks down the traditional generation boundaries. While there are those who delight at the thought of youngsters addressing their elders by their first names, generation boundaries are essential to an effective family structure. When these are distorted or lost, aggression, hostility, insecurity, and frustrations usually develop among the youth. In some cases, overt mental illness can result.

Television Although we tend to blame vanishing social institutions for the disappearance of childhood, God still holds parents responsible for the protection, training, and well-being of their offspring. All too often, parents, obsessed with personal fulfillment or social or business success, inadvertently surrender their children to exploitation. While some unfortunate incidents have arisen through situations involving human baby-sitters, many more arise when the baby-sitter is an electronic one — the ever-present television set.

A subsequent chapter is devoted entirely to an analysis of television's role in today's society, but certain points should be included here. Television, more than any other single factor, provides children with information that was traditionally reserved for adults. Television is a compelling force

that serves not only as a training school for initiation into the adult world, but also as a broadcaster of gloom, which emphasizes the stress of living in a world teetering on the brink of destruction. Certainly our world, because of technological advances, is not the stable planet it once was. But tiny minds were never intended to be bombarded with the potential problem of survival in a nuclear war.

Then there is the matter of using young children as pawns in national marketing schemes that reach into the billions of dollars. Children who are habitual (and unregulated) viewers are exposed to *hours* of commercials directed at adult viewers. While the immediate effects of such commercials may not seem important, the subtle, long-range effects can be far more revealing than one may think.

Television doesn't just sell products, it sells attitudes. Unfortunately, many of the attitudes promoted on television are not healthy or even realistic. TV promises to satisfy the child's (and the adult's) needs and wants—but seldom delivers in an effective way. It can lead to early disillusionment and a lifelong attitude of suspicion and cynicism. Commercials also use people's insecurities as a lever to induce unnecessary spending. Such steady manipulations of a person's weak points can eventually lead to mental problems.

If we are truly concerned about our children's welfare and development, we will make ourselves aware of the *hidden* messages constantly beamed to the child's subconscious. Such messages aren't accidental; they are boasted about by admen and TV promoters and are known as "subliminal" suggestions. They deliberately set out to instill attitudes and values in our younger generation that are *not* those that parents desire for their children.

Most commercial messages aren't lost on young minds. When a commercial declares that "gentlemen prefer Hanes," no little girl is going to rush out to buy pantyhose — but it can leave the lifelong impression that women must dress to please men, that the attention of men is a competitive market, and that if one is to compete successfully in this market, one must use *all* the weapons at one's disposal. Once the youngster reaches adolescence, this apparently innocuous subliminal message could be a factor in inducing promiscuity.

The day-in, day-out repetition of suggestive messages can't help having an influence on the attitudes of children. Though mom and dad may speak out against something, the kids see all the sophisticated people on television doing it, so who suffers by comparison? Stuffy old mom and dad do, of course. No one can question the social and economic success of

those serving as role models on TV, so why pay any attention to what the old fogeys think?

Television, for example, exalts the use of alcohol, intimating that alcohol consumption is glamorous or macho. Television shows and commercials lead youngsters to believe that drinking is not only desirable but necessary for social acceptance. Although alcoholism was long considered an exclusively adult problem, it is now becoming one of the major problems associated with growing up. We find full-blown alcoholics in their early teens, and they are not isolated cases. Teenage alcoholism is an epidemic, and its consequences (auto accidents, injuries, permanent paralysis, etc.) are among the major tragedies of teenage living today. Statistics also show that the youth of our nation consume as much marijuana, cocaine, and heroine as do adults.

Sex Miseducation Both the drug and alcohol industries are divided into two groups: the abusers and the users. The pornography industry also caters to two distinct groups: the demented porno addict and the curious. Unfortunately, our children are all too often the curious, and they don't have much trouble finding material to satisfy their curiosity. Not only are printed materials readily available, but also hour after hour of frankly prurient visual materials are beamed into our own homes every day. Who watches this filth? You're right, the babies we are trying to "raise unto righteousness."

Television promotes and glorifies promiscuous and perverted sex. Television's preoccupation with sex and the transference of its preoccupation to our young people is unquestionably a factor in the rise of venereal disease, illegitimate births, abortion, sex crimes, and the breakdown of the family. The consequences of pushing children into adult sex situations mushrooms in all directions as a frightening aspect of our "modern" society.

Television's view of sex actually makes the perverse seem glamorous. Young, prepubescent girls are regularly presented in commercials and printed ads as sex objects. They are presented as worldly and sexually attractive potential partners. There is no question of the role they represent — they're "Lolitas." They know what it's all about, and they aren't opposed to anything. It wasn't so long ago that even suggesting sexual activities with minors was an offense that could land you in prison for a long time. Today, TV executives and admen do it routinely and society passively accepts it.

Within a civilized society, it is generally accepted that sexual impulses must be rigidly controlled. Pressure is constantly placed upon adults to "cool it in public." Sexually suggestive actions just aren't acceptable around children. A barrier of secrecy is considered the proper shield to protect children from information that can be disturbing or harmful.

But what does television do? It throws open the gates and immerses the youngest and most innocent of children in a labyrinth of responsibilities and concerns that cause many adults problems. When this occurs, it tears down a major boundary separating childhood from adulthood.

Today's children are hard to distinguish from adults. They dress like adults, demand inclusion in adult conversations, and participate in adult recreations. In short, they are just small adults functioning in an adult world.

Unfortunately, most do not have the mental and emotional resources to cope with an adult environment. Their collection of wisdom and experiences fall woefully short of equipping them for grown-up responsibilities. As children openly indulge in sex, drugs, and alcohol (not to mention crime and perversions), it becomes painfully evident that we are paying an awesome price for television and its values. Suicides, drug overdoses, violent deaths, alcoholism—they're all part of the price our youngsters pay for the *privilege* of wandering unprepared into an adult world. Does this sound a little like conditions in the Middle Ages?

Of course, history *does* repeat itself. As a wise man once said, those who don't learn from it are doomed to live through it again. Civilizations come and civilizations go. History recounts the manner in which the events of one age are repeated again (sometimes over and over) in succeeding ages. It records man's efforts to elevate himself above the bondage that often seems to be his lot in life.

But bondage isn't man's lot as intended by God. Bondage is always imposed by

some other man or group of men. Today, there are clearly men who feel that Christian virtues and traits are unnecessary or unacceptable and so must be excised from our society. These are the men who principally control our media today. They are consciously striving to root out every vestige of Christianity and replace it with anarchy, vileness, pornography, and atheism.

Thus far, they've done a mammoth job. It would seem that they're about three-quarters of the way down the road toward reaching their goal. And to be painfully frank, as long as Christians blindly support them by watching television, buying movie tickets, and subscribing to (or even peeking at) the girlie magazines, it won't take long to *finish* the job.

I think its' apparent that we're nearing the end of our age. The disciples asked Jesus (in Matthew 24 and Luke 21) what the signs would be to indicate the time. He gave a number of signs, and Paul and other Bible writers gave additional signs in a number of places throughout the Old and New Testaments. Among these was the list of traits pointed out by Paul in II Timothy 3:2-4, which he said would characterize the general state of humanity in "the last days":

"For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers,

disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good, traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God."

Perhaps —unknowingly — we are responsible for creating such a people, especially among the younger group.

God has given us the resources to protect our children and to insulate our homes against the forces of evil. It is our grave responsibility to prolong the innocence of childhood while we train our children to be mighty in spirit, not wise in the wavs of the world.


In the Old Testament, the family with children was presented as the key unit of society. David, God's great psalmist, wrote in Psalm 127:3, 5: "Children are an heritage of the LORD ... Happy is the man who has his quiver full of them."

Proverbs 22:6 speaks with regard to child-rearing, saying it is our responsibility to "train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it."

Judeo-Christian ethics maintain a high regard for children, placing the highest of priorities on the welfare and education of the child. Children are commanded to honor their fathers and their mothers, while parents are cautioned to diligently teach the commandments of the Lord unto their children.

In the New Testament, children are esteemed as a gift from God. Jesus Himself reinforced the Old Testament teachings when He invited the little children to be brought unto Him. Wherever Christians have been found throughout history, this ethic profoundly influenced society. Within the Christian point of view, children were seen as much more than chattels. They had an intrinsic worth and value within themselves because of their potential as God-fearing adults. Each was considered a divine creature possessing the dignity of human life and the precious commodity of an eternal soul.

Neither did early Christians shrug their shoulders at the heathen practices of infanticide, pedophilia, and abortion commonly practiced about them. Instead, they challenged the pagan Mediterranean world. They were also the operators of the first orphanages for unwanted or abused children. 🦝

Q&A WITH SISTER SWAGGART

Will Christians go through any part of the great tribulation?

The answer is no. Christians will not go through the great tribulation because they won't be here. We believe the rapture of the church will take place before the great tribulation begins.

Let's walk through this, beginning with the rapture of the church. And, when we speak of the rapture, we are talking about the event detailed in I Thessalonians 4:16-17: "For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord."

These two verses summarize the rapture of the church, also known as the resurrection, the catching away, the blessed hope—when every believer who has ever lived will be instantly changed and given

glorified bodies.

Just think of that moment when generations and generations of saints actually meet the Lord in the air—from righteous Abel to every person found in Christ the minute the trump sounds. This great gathering of the redeemed will actually form "clouds" of saints—praise God!

The rapture of the church is the next great event on the horizon of time. We believe it could happen at any moment, and this is where we find some disagreement in the body of Christ.

The argument rages on as to whether or not the church will go through the great tribulation, but there is absolutely nothing in Scripture that indicates the church will either enter the great tribulation or pass through it. In Matthew 24, Israel is given many signs that will warn her of the near approach of that period, but the Gospels and the epistles are devoid of any signs to the church concerning this question.

On the timeline of biblical prophecy, there is no other place for the rapture; it has to be before the great tribulation as the following Scriptures show:

• "Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things [the tribulation] that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man" (Luke 21:36).

- "For God hath not appointed us to wrath [the tribulation], but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ" (I Thess. 5:9).
- "The mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he [the church] who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way. And then shall that Wicked be revealed ..." (II Thess. 2:7-8).
- "After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, Come up hither, and I will shew thee things which must be hereafter [after the rapture of the church]" (Rev. 4:1).

And consider this: while the church is mentioned seventeen times in the first three chapters of the book of Revelation, it is never mentioned thereafter as being on the earth. That's because the church, at that point, will be in heaven.

Even so, we have people call in or email to say, "If I miss the rapture, I'll just get saved during the tribulation," as if the rapture is some sort of dress rehearsal before the main event. Can a person get saved during the tribulation? Yes, it will be possible. My husband has said many times that there will be a lot of repentance taking place the moment after the rapture. And Donnie added that the most-read book during the great tribulation will probably be the Bible, since millions of them will be left in this world.

But it will be far more difficult to be saved during the tribulation because the body of Christ—those whom the Lord referred to as His witnesses, as salt, and as light of the world—will be gone. During the tribulation, the whole atmosphere will darken and become far more negative than it is now. It's going to be a terrible time. So I would ask those who plan on getting saved during the tribulation period, if you can't live for the Lord now, how will you live for the Lord then?

In Matthew 24:21 Jesus said, "For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be."

The great tribulation will be a time when divine wrath is to be visited on the earth, particularly upon Israel, but the promise to the church is that it has been delivered from the wrath to come.

Romans 5:9 says, "Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him."

If the church is destined to suffer, surely the Bible would have mentioned it. Some claim that the church has to go through the great tribulation to be purified, but that places the shed blood of the Lord Jesus Christ in a negative position. The Bible plainly teaches that the blood of Jesus Christ, God's Son, cleanses from all sin (I John 1:7). If it takes the great tribulation to purify the church, then what about the church throughout past generations? No. The truth is, purification comes about as

one evidences faith in Christ and what Christ did for us at the cross.

Again, the rapture of the church will take place before the great tribulation begins. And while the earth suffers through it, the saints of God will be in heaven, to stand before the judgment seat of Christ and then attend the marriage supper of the Lamb.

The purpose of the judgment seat of Christ will be to judge the works of every believer. The judgment of the believer's sins is already past, for Jesus bore our sins in His body on the cross at Calvary. Our sins never will be brought to our account again, for they have been forgiven and forgotten. However, a careful ledger has been kept of every work the believer has performed since he has become a Christian. Believers will be judged on: the basis of their doctrinal beliefs, true or false; conduct toward others, kind or unkind; stewardship, faithful or unfaithful; words, good or bad; talents, used or wasted; attitudes, Christlike or selfish; motives, right

or wrong; traits, spiritual or carnal; and deeds, worthy or worthless.

The deeds performed in a worthy manner will be rewarded, but those deeds Christ judges unworthy will be burned and will cause the believer lost rewards.

Following the judgment seat of Christ will be the marriage supper of the Lamb attended by all the redeemed from every dispensation who will live in the New Jerusalem, which is the bride of Christ.

John the Revelator wrote: "Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready. And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints. And he saith unto me, Write, Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb" (Rev. 19:7-9).

I am so looking forward to the rapture and seeing the Lord Jesus Christ face-to-face. What a day of rejoicing that will be!

"In the end of the sabbath, as it began to dawn toward the first day of the week, came Mary Magdalene and the other Mary to see the sepulchre. And, behold, there was a great earthquake: for the angel of the Lord descended from heaven, and came and rolled back the stone from the door, and sat upon it. Tell



Evangelism and Discipleship Within the Local Church

There has never been a greater opportunity to reach a community for Christ than now. However, reaching a community is more than just being seen, it's also teaching the community about who Jesus is and what He has done for them.

The Gospel Is Not Caught, But Rather Taught

Pastoring is one of the most important aspects of ministry, and it is a mandate from God. To fulfill this specific calling, the pastor must be filled, anointed, led, and instructed by the Holy Spirit. The gospel cannot be caught, but rather taught, simply because it is the driving force behind doctrine and actualization within the community. There are people who are hurting and need direction in their lives, and the one who can truly provide that direction is the God-called pastor.

Relationship building is key in any endeavor in the community, and the pastor must be involved in the social lives of the community. However, the pastor must find that balance between building relationships and demonstrating Christianity without watering down the message

of the cross. The gospel is not caring for those who are less fortunate or social interaction, yet that is what is expected by Christians.

Evangelism And Making Disciples

The people a pastor serves have lives outside of church, which means the local church and pastor must have some knowledge or insight into the kind of community they serve. One must become familiar with his surroundings to see the opportunities available. No church that refuses to look beyond its borders will ever grow, which means that opportunities are endless right outside the door.

The church is called to go out into the highways and byways, and the world around it and make disciples, teaching them to observe all things that Christ has commanded (Matt. 28:19-20). In

verse 19, the word *teach* means "to disciple," which must ever be the focus of the local church. We have been given full authority by Christ to carry on the work of our Commander in Chief, and time is of the essence. We must leave the comfort of our four walls and reach the community around us.

The church is a called-out body, separated from the world. However, the misconception is that we are to be removed from all worldly things and the people within. Yes, we are called to be separate, but we are not called to be isolated. There is a difference. We are not of this world and our home is not this world, but while we are here, we are commanded to be fishers of men. The greatest thing we could give our neighbors is the gospel of Jesus Christ, and, seeing that this is the greatest news ever given, why are we



so hesitant to share it?

Any pastor desires growth. Nevertheless, to achieve growth, there has to be an effective plan to reach the community. The church must cast its net on the outside of the boat and compel them to enter into the house of God (Luke 14:23). This is not accomplished by the pastor alone; it takes the entire congregation, and sound doctrine teaches the local body how to

properly fish for the lost.

Not only is the local pastor to be a fisher of men, but also a nurturer of the body. In other words, fulfilling the Great Commission involves evangelism and discipleship. Be visible within the community to win souls for Christ and nurturing to the flock for growth. The church should always be viewed as a spiritual hospital for the spiritually afflicted. It should be a place where

the hurting can find comfort, the lost can find salvation, and the sick can experience healing. The church needs to view itself in that vein. When it does, the vision and perspective of the local body changes. To be honest, the church cannot disciple anyone until people are won to Christ; the church is not properly fulfilling the Great Commission just by witnessing. There needs to be a balance of evangelism and discipleship for the overall growth of the body of Christ.

Love God, Love People

On a personal note, the phrase "love God, love people" is not just a catchphrase or a cool pastoral slogan; it is my heart. My calling is to be a pastor, and for me to walk in my calling, I must apply this command. If the love of God does not extend to love of my fellowman, then my claim to love God and people is a false statement. I firmly believe that when a person has a heart for God, he or she will also have a heart for people. People are people, meaning that every person is different and comes with his or her own personal baggage. Yet, that does not mean we are to look past the less fortunate and only look for those who are more like us. As stated, opportunities are endless if we choose to put this lifestyle of loving God and loving people into practice.

There is a question that I must ask you: is there a fire burning bright for souls within the local body, or has that flame of passion for church growth gone out? If you do not see a passion for souls or the desire to disciple the flock, then I suggest you find some place that does. At the same time, I want to present a question, or maybe even a challenge to you—are you doing your part in fulfilling the Great Commission? If not, what are you going to do about it? *





Abortion or Trust God

"I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live."

-DEUTERONOMY 30:19

IN THE LATE 1980s and early 1990s, Donna and I were in pastoral ministry in Mobile, Alabama. I will never forget a certain day in May of 1989. We had had a busy day, but I was now home; Donna was doing something in the kitchen, and I was about to watch a little news on TV.

At about 9 p.m., I received a phone call from two of our church members, a young married couple, Kimberly and David. By the tone of Kimberly's voice, I could tell something very bad was going on. I had officiated their wedding, so I knew them quite well. At this time, David and Kimberly were in the military, stationed at Norfolk, Virginia. Kimberly had been crying, and she just let it gush out: "Pastor, we need prayer. We don't know what to do!" David was beside her, but he was very quiet.

I said, "Kimberly, what is going on, what is happening?"
With much emotion and feeling, she and David shared with me that she was pregnant, and the doctor had given them some very bad news. After reviewing the blood test and other tests, the doctor was convinced

that they should abort their unborn child. Kim was in her fifth month of pregnancy.

She said, "We met with the doctor today, and he shared with us the results of various blood tests. He told us that the tests revealed that the unborn child probably has a serious biological genetic defect called Down syndrome, and he thinks that we should consider abortion. We don't believe in abortion. Pastor Gray, what should we do?"

All of this was shared with much anguish and heartache. I could sense their pain and confusion.

I spent a few moments trying to get my composure and decided immediately to pray for them. Even though they were hundreds of miles from me—they were in Virginia, and I was in Alabama—I still asked them to join hands, and I prayed for God's comfort and wisdom to be upon them and to help them to know and do God's perfect will. They settled down just a little, and the Holy Spirit spoke to my heart very quickly and strongly and said, "They must not abort this child. This child must live and not die."

I will never forget what I did or said at this point in the discussion. With strong boldness, I insisted, "David, go to your



kitchen and get some oil to anoint Kimberly." I asked him to take the oil, anoint her, and lay his hands on her stomach. "Together," I said, "we are going to pray for complete healing and do a baby dedication, even though the child is unborn.

David got the oil, he and Kimberly both laid their hands on her stomach, and I led them in a prayer of dedication and healing. We prayed for God's protection and healing for that unborn child. We prayed, "Father, if this child has a serious physical problem or illness, we ask You to heal this baby and remove this condition from its little body and make it completely whole. Lord, allow this pregnancy to go full term and allow this child to be born well and healthy."

When we finished our prayer meeting and baby dedication, I said to David and Kimberly, "We have prayed the prayer of faith over this child; we have done what God's Word tells us to do. Now, the two of you must trust God totally for whatever happens. I will continue to join with you all in faith and believe that the baby will be born healthy without any physical problems. But we must leave this baby in the hands of God, knowing that God is in control."

I asked them, "Do you agree to not abort this baby and trust God completely with the outcome?" With tears and much emotion, they both said, "Yes." I shared a few more words from Scripture, prayed a brief prayer, and we hung up. That was May 1989.

In or about 1996, Donna and I were visiting the incredible Brownsville Revival in Pensacola, Florida where Evangelist Steve Hill was preaching. At the end of

the service, I saw Kimberly coming toward us. We had not seen Kimberly or David for about six or seven years. She rushed up to us and said, "Do you see that little

blonde-headed girl over there coming our way?"

I said yes.

"That is Britney," she almost shouted, "the child the doctor wanted to abort in May of 1989!" Britney walked to her mother and Kimberly said, "Britney, this is Pastor Don Paul and Donna Gray. They used to be our pastors. I want you to meet them." We rejoiced and wept and hugged. God had given David and Kim a beautiful little blonde-headed girl in perfect health!

Just recently, I heard that Kimberly's daughter, Britney, had gotten married, and she and her husband now have a beautiful daughter named Iliana. Wow, God is so merciful and good!

But what if they had done what the doctor wanted them to do on that day in May of 1989? There would be no Britney and no Iliana—just a life of regrets for David and Kimberly.

Since *Roe v. Wade* in 1973, more than sixty million babies have been murdered in the wombs of their mothers by doctors and nurses in America. There were 889,000 abortions here in America in 2019. Did you know that twenty-two percent of all pregnancies end up in abortion? Statistics tell us that fifty percent of women getting abortions are twenty-five years old and younger. How sad is that?

Dear friends, Deuteronomy 30:19 admonishes us to choose life not death. The following Scriptures remind us that God is fully aware of each one of us

while still in our mother's womb:

- "For thou hast possessed my reins: thou hast covered me in my mother's womb," (Ps. 139:13).
- "Thus saith the LORD that made thee, and formed thee from the womb" (Isa. 44:2).
- "Before I formed thee in the belly, I knew thee" (Jer. 1:5).

In May of 1989, David and Kimberly made the right decision concerning her pregnancy. They chose life and not death. Consequently, God truly blessed them for obeying God's Word. Today, they greatly enjoy their daughter Britney and now their granddaughter, Iliana. They are blessed! The Law of Faith

Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? of works? Nay: but by the law of faith. Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law." -ROMANS 3:27-28

Three Laws of the New Covenant

There are three great laws that attach themselves to the new covenant. Every believer should be aware of their existence, their meaning, and how they apply to God's redemption plan under Christ. They are:

- 1. The law of faith
- 2. The law of the Spirit of life in Christ **Jesus**
 - 3. The law of Christ

If the believer fails to understand or apply any of these laws to his life as a believer, then the Christian experience will be far less than it should be for that individual. In the next few months, we will attempt to briefly describe each of these great laws. These laws are general in nature, much like the law of gravity. They describe truths that are "constants." In other words, they never change what

they are for anyone, and they always work the way that God has designed them to work. Let us first take a look at the law of faith.

The Law of Faith

To best understand the law of faith, we must first look closely at the literary content of Romans 3:19-31. In the first three chapters of Romans, Paul has established that both Jew and Gentile consistently fail to rise to the purity and moral excellence of God. In fact, Paul has proven that all men are dominated by sin and that they are constantly falling short of God's glory. Therefore, all men are in need of a Savior.

Paul's theology demanded that both Jew and Gentile enter into a state of justification through faith in Jesus Christ. He taught that it was faith in Christ's atoning sacrifice that both established and

maintained relationship with God. Justification is only available through the means of faith as opposed to "law-keeping." We are never acceptable to God through the agency of religious works! One is properly aligned with God through faith alone.

In Romans 3:25, Paul also unveils the proper object of our faith. Here he states that Christ was set forth as a propitiation for us through "faith in His blood." It is the event of Christ giving His life on the cross that our faith must reside in. The moment the believing sinner places his faith in Christ's atoning sacrifice, God declares him legally justified. Being justified is a God-granted position that properly aligns man with the righteousness of God.

When man is properly aligned in relationship with God, all that God has offered through covenant relationship becomes available. All of the blessings that are accessible to mankind are the result of Christ "cutting this new covenant" at Calvary. As long as we stay aligned with God by faith, all the benefits of this new covenant can continually flow and are freely distributed to the believer by the Holy Spirit. We do not labor for these benefits. We are only able to experience them, by carefully and continuously observing the law of faith.

A Justified Life

The law of faith must be a constant in our lives. When we place our faith in Christ initially, we experience salvation. It is also necessary that the believer stay aligned properly with God by always maintaining simple faith in Christ. In Romans 1:17, Galatians 3:11, and again in Hebrews 10:38, the New Testament declares that "the just shall live by faith." So then, the justified man or woman is to live by means of faith and not works. Paul taught us that the law of Moses was a law of works. He also stated that "the law is not of faith" (Gal. 3:12).



We are called upon to live a "justified" life. Whenever our faith is directed toward something other than Christ and Him crucified, the believer comes "out of alignment" with his new covenant relationship with God. Like a car whose wheels are out of alignment, things will fail to work properly. When the believer is out of alignment with God, the Holy

Spirit cannot do all that He desires to do. God's grace is then limited because the believer is not properly aligned with God. A person does not straightway relinquish his justified state by getting out of alignment. Yet He does hinder the benefits that could be flowing to him because he is not properly lined up to receive them.

We enter into eternal life by faith. Then,

"We are never acceptable to God through the agency of religious works! One is **properly aligned** with God through faith alone." we are to experience abundant life by living a justified life by faith. There forever remains only one proper object of faith, that being Christ and the cross. We must not depend upon disciplines, proper Christian action, biblical standards, or associations with godly people to align us with God each day. We can only be aligned properly with God when our faith is securely placed and maintained in Christ and the cross. When we keep our faith in who Christ is and what Christ has done then we can expect the power of God to continually transform us into the image of Christ. If we fail to consistently depend upon Christ and the cross, we are not living a justified life. We have come out of alignment with God. The Holy Spirit, though still present within us, is limited to the degree that we are out of alignment. We must live by the law of faith and place no trust in what we do. Thereby, we live a justified life.

The Place of Works

Where do works fit into the life of the believer? Is a justified life freed from the responsibility of a holy life? God forbid! I agree wholeheartedly that we must pursue a life of holiness, without which no man will see God. The question is not whether we should pursue holiness. It is really about how we attempt to live holy. If we are in alignment with God because of the law of faith, then the disciplines, actions, and attitudes prevalent to the Christian life will surface. Paul said in Ephesians 2:10, "we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works." We must understand that only the law of faith places us into Christ and positions us to become the creative work of God. If this first law is embraced, it will prepare us for the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus, which we will cover in next month's article.

REVIVAL

REVIVAL IS WHAT God does for the church while the Great Commission is what the church does for God. Since the late 1950s, the church has become indifferent toward God and His Word, as worldliness, and now sinfulness, is accepted and practiced in the church. The emphasis on the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ has moved to how we "do" church. Church numbers have become the litmus test for church health instead of sound doctrine and holy living. The idea of a changed life today means one's conformity to modern church methods and social justice with good works, instead of the working power of the Holy Spirit that transforms a life into the image of Jesus Christ.

What Is Revival?

In a biblical sense, revival has meant a move of God throughout a whole region involving many churches with Christians being lifted out of worldliness and into conviction of sin, solemn desires for more of Jesus Christ and His Word, purity of life, conversions of souls through the boldness to witness, joyful worship, and a renewed commitment to missions. I believe God has been supplying revival to believers throughout the SonLife Broadcasting Network (SBN) since 2010. Revival at SBN began with God moving upon believers to pray. The prayer meetings, which began in Baton Rouge preceding the birth of SBN, have now broadened to

individuals throughout the viewing and listening audience. All the earmarks of revival are witnessed and experienced in all the regions where SBN is airing.

When Jesus Christ is lifted up and magnified for His work on the cross, the Holy Spirit begins to work in the hearts of God's children. He meets their needs while also conforming them to the image of Christ. God's will becomes the will of His people. As this occurs, there is a hunger and desire to see lost souls saved and delivered out of the bondages of sins.

Historical Example Of Revival

In the late 1940s, two elderly women in their eighties-Peggy and Christine Smith—lived in the village of Barvas, which is on the Isle of Lewis in the Hebrides off the coast of Scotland. Both ladies were sick in their bodies and unable to physically attend church. Their residence became a sanctuary for prayer, and it was there that God began to speak to their hearts. God gave them a promise, "I will pour water upon him that is thirsty and floods upon dry ground." Peggy and Christine diligently sought the Lord as He led them to pray. A beautiful revelation came one night to Peggy, and the Lord began to tell her that revival was coming and the church of her fathers would be crowded again with young people. She called for the Rev. James Murray MacKay and shared what God revealed to her and asked him to get the deacons together for a time of prayer and supplication. During those times of prayer, the Spirit of God began to move. Peggy claimed she heard from the Lord that God was sending someone to lead the new revival. Duncan Campbell was called upon by Pastor MacKay but rejected several invitations prior to accepting his request to visit Lewis Island. Campbell agreed to come for ten days, and ten days turned into three years! The Lord began to move with the Holy Spirit calling the prayer warriors to repentance. They all sought God for a pure and clean heart as they prepared themselves for His service. Many others began to be saved as Holy Spirit conviction fell throughout





the islands. A deep hunger grew among the people, especially the young, and an overwhelming love for God grew in their hearts. There was a young fifteen-year-old boy that got saved and became one of the prayer warriors. So diligent in prayer was this young boy that he was called upon by ministers to pray at meetings as the power of God was sure to fall. Between 1949 and 1952 a widespread revival and harvest swept throughout the Hebrides.

Earmarks Of Revival And Awakenings

Revivals supply a spiritual renewal to believers. They bring new hope and fresh faith. In one sense, they reenergize the church to fulfill the Great Commission. The first earmark of revival is the desire to see people saved.

In the Hebrides revival, the idea of eternal destiny was strongly preached. Duncan Campbell used the phrase "hell-deserving sinners" to have the lost consider their eternal destiny, either heaven or hell.

The preaching was biblical expository preaching and nothing like today's motivational feel-good sermons. The Word of God was powerfully preached with the accompanying anointing of the Holy Spirit. Witnesses have said it caused the hearers to burst out into tears with sobs and repentance.

The Hebrides Revival was known as a young people's phenomenon. Many teenagers and those under the age of forty gave their lives to Jesus Christ.

The fear of God spread out to the other nearby islands of the Hebrides, and many were saved in the church services, but also while walking in the countryside. God was moving powerfully. Unusual manifestations were occurring. These spontaneous manifestations, with some saying that on their way home in the dark, bright lights would appear to help them find their way home. Another interesting manifestation was the fact that people would linger after services for hours and head home only to continue worshipping the Lord. Many would stay up until 2 a.m.,

but be up and ready for work at 7 a.m. Although it defies natural explanation, they kept this up for nearly three years as God anointed them with little need for sleep.

As with any true move of God, one may expect opposition, and opposition was no stranger to the Hebrides Revival. It is one thing to have opposition from the world of non-believers, but opposition to the Hebrides

Revival came from Christians. The town of Stornoway—the capital of the Isle of Lewis—was completely bypassed by God. The town's ministers opposed and rejected the revival. Only the small towns and villages enjoyed what God was doing. Stornoway missed it because its ministers rejected it. Is it not unreasonable for us today to see the same thing happening again? The people missed the touch of God because the ministers of Stornoway did not discern what God was doing in their midst.

There is one more interesting caveat to the Hebrides Revival. Peggy and Christine Smith had a niece, Mary Anne Smith MacLeod. She emigrated from the Island of Lewis to America and met Frederick Trump, and they were married in January 1936. Although this preceded the 1949-1952 revival, there was an historic awakening in the 1820s on the Hebrides Islands that provoked a powerful move of God. Every homeowner in those days, and for decades afterward, built altars in their homes and lived for God. There is no doubt that Mary Anne Smith MacLeod was greatly influenced by the Lord and an altar in her home. Peggy and Christine Smith prayed that God would touch their little island with a move of God.

> and He did. Who would have thought that their niece,

the mother of Donald Trump, would one day bear a son who would become the president of the United States? On his mother's Bible, President Trump would

take his oath to protect and uphold the Constitution of the

United States—a nation born after its own Great Awakening! *

The Double-Headed Serpent

Last month, we addressed one head of the serpent: sinless perfection. We saw that it is unscriptural for someone to declare that he had arrived at perfection. Jesus taught that in the model prayer, to ask for your daily bread and ask for forgiveness of sin. While writing to believers, John said, "If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us" (I John 1:8). Now we will look at spiritual complacency—the second head of the serpent.

"Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you." - James 4:7



Spiritual Complacency Defined

Spiritual complacency, also known as spiritual apathy, is a self-serving lifestyle that justifies sin and compromise. It says, "Everybody sins. I'll never arrive at sinless perfection, therefore, why try?" The spiritually complacent lose the spiritual battle by default, and they are ok with that; after all, it's an easier life. It's a life that fulfills the desires of the flesh more than God's desires for the individual.

Be Holv?

We are called to be holy (I Peter 1:15). We will never arrive at sinless perfection. However, there are many who go to the opposite extreme and live a complacent life of compromise. There are times when we become distracted, or we start to rely on our own spiritual abilities resulting in sin. We must remember, holiness is a prayer away. "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (I John 1:9).

Walk In The Spirit

Paul instructed the churches of Galatia to "Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh." (Gal. 5:16). There are two

options and only two options presented: walk in the Spirit or walk in the flesh. Spiritual complacency says, "It's too hard to walk in the Spirit. It's easier to walk in the flesh. It's more fun." The problem is, the Spirit cannot peacefully cohabit with the flesh. They are antithetical enemies. Walking in the Spirit pleases God. Walking in the flesh is the devil's playground.

Submit And Resist

We are commanded by God's Word to "Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you" (James 4:7). There are three parts to this verse. Two of them, we are responsible to do: submit to God and resist the devil. If we do this acknowledging that our victory was won at Calvary on an old rugged cross, then the third part will

be automatic. When we properly submit to God, and we properly resist the devil, then he must flee.


This, however, is too much effort for the spiritually complacent. We are called to live a life of submission to God while resisting the devil. As His children, we should desire walk in holiness. When we fail, we immediately repent and return to a walk of holiness.

Resisting The Holy Spirit

Instead of resisting the devil, the spiritually complacent find themselves in danger of resisting the Holy Spirit. Jesus said that when the Holy Spirit would come into the world "...He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment" (John 16:8). There is a well-known preacher who insists that the Holy Spirit

will never convict the saint. He interprets this verse as saying that the Holy Spirit convicts "the world" and not the church. He also teaches that it is blasphemous to ask God for forgiveness seeing that Jesus had already paid the price for all of our sins. Another, of the same disposition, says that God knows we are going to sin and therefore expects us to enjoy our sin.

Do you see the danger in this type of thinking? If you are no longer allowing the Holy Spirit to convict you of compromise and sin, then you are in danger of becoming spiritually complacent. If we resist the Holy Spirit while He is attempting to bring us back into right relationship with God, then we are on a slippery slope. Stay diligent. Resist the double-headed serpent of sinless perfection and spiritual complacency.



I Know Whom I Have Belived

"I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day." —II TIMOTHY 1:12



THREE TIMES IN these few phrases Paul uses the word I to indicate that God is a personal God. He is not just the God of parents or pastors; he is also a personal God. He knew everything about Paul and still loved him enough to die for him (John 15:13; Rom. 5:8). God was concerned about everything Paul was and everything he had. God had a personal plan and purpose for Paul's life. God was more than some impersonal blob in the universe who could't care less about Paul. As these different song lyrics say, "He knows my name," and "I am a friend of God."

Not only did God know about Paul, but He also had a personal relationship with him because of who Christ was and what He accomplished on the cross. In II Timothy 1:12, notice that the word *know* is in the present tense. That means Paul not only

knew God by experiencing Him in the past or hoping to know Him in the future, but Paul also had a day-to-day, ongoing relationship with him.

Not only did God know Paul, but Paul knew God as the Creator, sustainer of the universe, his personal Savior, and Lord. He not only paid the penalty for Paul's sins, but also provided power to overcome the dominion of sin, and, ultimately, the very presence of sin. God made a way of conquering sickness and death, and gave Paul eternal life. He gave Paul hope and peace, not only for the past and future, but also for the present.

Paul was persuaded. He had been so wrapped up in who he was and what he could do to try to make himself acceptable to God, but none of it worked. There was still something missing. There was still an

emptiness that all of his own efforts and success could not satisfy. He could not understand the peace, tranquility, and forgiveness that Stephen showed to the very people who stoned him to death. He also sensed the constant prodding of the Holy Spirit toward the love and forgiveness of God that climaxed when he met Jesus on the road to Damascus and surrendered his life to Him (Acts 9:5-6). All of this convinced Paul that God loved him and had a plan and purpose for his life.

Paul was also convinced that God was able to keep or guard everything he had and everything he was from the enemy of his soul who vowed to steal, kill, and destroy him. Because of who God was and His relationship with Paul, there was a hedge of protection around him that Satan could not come through unless God allowed it. And that only happened when the problem would be for Paul's good—if


"God had a personal plan and purpose for Paul's life."

he responded to it with his faith in the cross (Rom. 8:28; II Cor. 12:7-10; Rom. 5:3-5; James 1:2-4; II Peter 1:5-7).

But that was just the beginning of a whole new life of believing God. Paul not only gave mental assent to the historical existence of God and Jesus Christ, but he committed everything he was and everything he had to the Lord. Even though, at this point, Paul did not have a physical family, he did have spiritual brothers and sisters, and children whom he had to completely give to God. Paul knew there was nothing he could do by himself to see them

be spiritually born, grow, live, and die. It all had to come through faith in Christ. He also had to be totally dependent on the Lord for his word and provision for himself and those who worked with him.

So Paul left his testimony that it was worth it all—he had no regrets, he would do it all over again, and he encouraged everyone else to do the same thing. Paul offered his life as an example of what God would do for anyone and everyone who would allow Him to persuade them so they would believe Him, commit their entire lives to Him, and follow Him.



I am obligated in every way to take this message of redemption to the entirety of the world. That includes every believer, and it includes you as well.


