



HOW HARD IS THIS?

At first glance, this seems to be a very simple thing, but once we really look at the cross of Christ, inspect it closely, and understand that our faith must be there and there alone, then we suddenly start to see problems. One of those problems is double-mindedness, and there cannot be any double-minded means or ways in our actions or attitudes. We cannot trust in Christ and what He has done for us at the cross while, at the same time, trusting in psychology or other such things. Most of the modern church has opted for humanistic psychology as the answer for the ills and aberrations of the human race. As a result, Christian bookstores are filled with this type of material. At the same time, fewer commentaries and reference books on the Bible are being produced. To my knowledge, the commentaries that I have written are some of the few that have been written in the past fifty years. Satan has been very successful at turning people away from the Bible and toward other things.

Paul said: "Now the Spirit (Holy Spirit) speaks expressly (pointedly) that in the latter times (the times in which we now live, the last of the last days, which begin the fulfillment of end-time prophecies) some shall depart from the faith (anytime Paul uses the term the faith, in short, he is referring to the cross; so, we are told here that some will depart from the cross as the means of salvation and victory) giving heed to seducing spirits (evil spirits, i.e., "religious spirits," making something seem like what it isn't), and doctrines of devils (should have been translated, "doctrines of demons"; the "seducing spirits" entice believers away from the true faith, causing them to believe "doctrines inspired by demon spirits")" (I Tim 4:1, The Expositor's Study Bible).

Most Christians misunderstand this and don't realize what the apostle is saying in this passage.

Satan, as it regards his "seducing spirits," does not look like Satan. He looks like the Lord. That is the very meaning of the word *seduction*. These spirits seduce people by making them think that what is being offered is of God. Paul said, "*Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light*" (II Cor. 11:14). Paul also referred to those who propagate such false doctrine as Satan's ministers (II Cor 11:15).

Any Bible student who studies Paul at all understands that he preached the cross, and not only the cross for salvation, but also as it relates to sanctification (which he preached on far more). If you'll notice, the entirety of the Bible deals very little with the salvation process. Yes, it definitely gives the manner in which people are saved, and it does so again and again. But the greater bulk of the Word of God is about telling people how to live for God after they get saved. Paul was the founder of the church, and the entirety of his fourteen epistles deal almost exclusively with the manner and means by which the believer should live for God. So his preaching of the cross dealt far more with sanctification than anything else.

No Christian need offer the excuse of not knowing what is right or wrong. The Holy Spirit resides in the heart of every believer, and a part of His office work is to "reprove (convict) of sin," and "to guide into all truth" (John 16:8, 13). So, if we engage in wrongdoing, it is because we have overridden the constant warnings of the Holy Spirit, or else, we do not know how to properly look to the cross, which guarantees the power of the Holy Spirit expended on our behalf, which can always defeat any power of darkness.

Having said that, let's look again at Galatians 5:19-21: "Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God." In these verses with special attention to "works of the flesh," Paul presents a catalog of sins, which are repulsive to the true believer. It's as if Paul is saying to the Galatians, "You have a clearly defined standard by which to decide whether you are being led by the Holy Spirit or by the flesh. Each is known by its peculiar works or fruits."

HOW DO THE WORKS OF THE FLESH MANIFEST THEMSELVES?

Many Christians look at the first four or five works of the flesh in these verses and dismiss the others, or else they pay little attention to what Paul said. The works of the flesh are ugly indeed. Some of them don't appear that way but come instead under the heading of "the doctrine of angels of light" (II Cor.11:13-14). To use just one of these—the teaching and believing of heresies, for example—this constitutes a work of the flesh, but most people would not think of such in that capacity. During Paul's day, the great error projected by Satan in the church was the problem of Judaism. It was the problem of trying to add law to grace. It said, in essence, that Christ did not finish the work on the cross, or else it gave the cross of Christ no place at all, which is usually the case. That was heresy then, and it's heresy now.

Also, if a Christian preacher were to include anything outside of the cross (and sadly most preachers do), then immorality in one way or another would usually rear its ugly head. That's why we're seeing so many Christians failing today—preachers included. Many of these people are trying with all their strength not to fail. But they are trying in the wrong way because they don't know the message of the cross. Consequently, their faith is placed in something else, which the Holy Spirit cannot honor. This makes believers a perfect target for the devil, and he takes advantage of these opportunities. Anything and everything the devil does is always ugly and without mercy.

WILLPOWER!

This brings us back to the subject of willpower. The church, not knowing or understanding the message of the cross as it refers to sanctification, relies mostly on willpower. Churches today, for the most part, teach that if a believer sins, it is simply because he wants to sin. If that's the case, then why did Paul say this: "For that which I do (the failure) I allow not (should have been translated, "I understand not"; these are not the words of an unsaved man, as some claim, but rather a believer who is trying and failing): For what I would, that do I not, but what I hate that do I" (Rom. 7:15). The apostle is saying that he finds himself doing the very thing that he doesn't want to do. And he is, in fact, fighting with all his strength not to do it. Read again what he said: "For that which I do I allow not: for what I would, that do I not; but what I hate that do I." And in Romans 7:18 Paul says, "for to will is present with me; but how to perform that which is good I find not." Paul tells us here that he is using his will—his willpower. But that simply was not enough. Despite exerting all of his willpower—and Paul was a strong individual—he still found himself doing the very thing that he did not want to do.

TRYING TO LIVE FOR GOD IN THE WRONG WAY

If the believer tries to live for the Lord by means of his willpower alone (as Paul was doing before he understood the message of the cross and as most believers do), then, as we mentioned before, Satan can literally override the believer's will and force him to do things that he doesn't want to do. This is very evident in Romans 7. When we say that Satan can override a believer's will, it scares most Christians, and rightly so, but it is the truth. However, Satan cannot override your will if your will is properly placed in Christ and what Christ has done for you at the cross. When the Christian says, "I will obey," he must understand that he can do so only in the capacity of the Holy Spirit working through him, which He does according to the believer's faith in Christ and His great sacrifice. We could try to claim, as many preachers do, that this passage in Romans 7 refers to Paul before his salvation, but that thinking is foolish, to say the least. No sinner is trying to quit sinning. In fact, sinners love sin. No, Romans 7 proclaims Paul's account after he was saved.

And this is very important: Paul is also saying that if the believer reverts back to means other than faith in the cross of Christ, then the result will be spiritual failure every time.

Naturally, a person's will is very important. The Christian has to will himself to live for God as the first prerogative of his experience with the Lord. The Scripture says, "*And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely*" (Rev. 22:17). That being the case, how does one's will come into play? The believer has to will himself to trust Christ and what Christ has done at the cross. This is the avenue and direction that the will must play. If the believer attempts to live for God in any other way, then it doesn't matter how much willpower

Jesus calls this experience the new birth. He told Nicodemus: "Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God" (John 3:3).

he uses; he will fail. The church teaches, erroneously, that the believer sins simply because he wills to do so. To be frank, I don't believe that's true of any believer. Admittedly, there are millions of people who go under the guise of Christians who are, in fact, not even saved, and these people will ultimately want to do things that are wrong. Even in a good Christian, the flesh might desire something that is not right. Paul dealt with that by saying, "*Now then it is no more I that do it, but sin* [the sin nature] *that dwelleth in me*" (Rom 7:17).

THE SIN NATURE

Even though it's only the flesh that desires those things, whatever those things may be, the believer is still responsible, and what he does is still looked at by God as sin. The believer has within him three natures:


- *Human nature*. Christ even had a human nature, as should be obvious.
- Divine nature. "Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust" (II Peter 1:4)
- *Sin nature*. The power of the sin nature was broken at the cross and its guilt was taken away, so this nature must not rule and reign in the Christian (Rom. 6:12). The sin nature in the heart of the believer is to be dormant.

Remember, justification means the penalty of sin was removed. Sanctification means the power of sin is broken. While the sin nature dwells in the Christian, it must not rule and reign in the Christian; it must remain dormant. If the believer does not function through Christ and Him crucified, then the sin nature will revive to rule and reign in that believer's life. Paul said, "*Let not sin* (the sin nature) *therefore reign* (rule) *in your mortal body*, (showing that the sin nature can once again rule in the heart and life of the believer if the believer doesn't constantly look to Christ and the cross; the 'mortal body' is neutral, which means it can be used for righteousness or unrighteousness), *that you should obey it in the lusts thereof* (ungodly lusts are carried out through the mortal body if faith is not maintained in the cross [I Cor. 1:17-18]) (Rom. 6:12, The Expositor's Study Bible). It would have made no sense for Paul to have said this if such were not possible, as many teach. No true Christian wants to sin. The divine nature is in him, and sin has now become abhorrent to him. Yet millions are sinning. Why? They are sinning because they are trying to address these things with willpower alone, which is woefully insufficient and will never work. You are to will yourself to live according to Christ and Him crucified, and that is as far as your will is to go. The Holy Spirit will do the rest. (Rom. 8:1-2; 11).

A PERSONAL EXAMPLE

In 1996, after seeking the Lord almost daily for several years, and many times with tears, He began to open up to me this great message of the cross. The moment the Holy Spirit began to reveal this great truth to me, I knew that I had found what I had sought for all those years. It wasn't new—the Lord had already given it to Paul and quite possibly others. He just helped me to understand what the great apostle had said what the Spirit of God had taught him.

You see, Paul's great cry, "*O*, *wretched man that I am*," was finally answered by the Lord when he gave to Paul the meaning of the new covenant, which is, in essence, the meaning of the cross. Jesus Christ is the new covenant, and the cross is the meaning of that covenant. And that meaning was given to the apostle Paul. Believers today are going to have to come to the place where they either choose what Paul taught, or they choose what some of these modern teachers are proclaiming, which is the opposite of what Paul taught. The believer who chooses what Paul taught may have to leave his church. He may have to change friends. His own family may turn against him. But this is the very price that Jesus said believers would have to pay.

It was two years ago this May that my husband's cousin, Mickey Gilley, went home to be with the Lord. We miss him, but we're so thankful that in his final years, he made things right with the Lord an answer to prayer. Specifically, we believe, an answer to his mother's prayers.

Keep Praying For Lost Loved Ones

AUNT RENE—that's what we called Mickey's mother—was a wonderful, wonderful Christian woman. She wanted her son to become a minister, but he wanted something different. Mickey said to his mother, "You're not going to approve of what I'm doing, but I'm going to ask one thing of you please don't pray against me. You don't have to pray for me, just don't pray against me, alright?" The fact that he would ask such a thing is a tremendous testimony to the power of his mother's prayers.

Yes, Aunt Rene knew how to pray. In Ferriday, where she lived, people were more open and friendly. Walking through neighborhoods, the sounds of family and home sifted through the screen doors of those shotgun houses and into the streets.

Living opposite Aunt Rene was her

sister, who was also my husband's grandmother-Nannie, he called her. Both of these women—Aunt Rene and Nannie-spent a lot of time in prayer, sometimes with other believers and sometimes alone. If you happened to be walking nearby their homes, there was a good chance you'd hear both of them praying, one on each side of the street, crying out to God for unsaved loved ones, for revival, and for the needs of their small Assembly of God church. They sometimes got loud, but they were unashamed that neighbors might hear. They were more concerned with what God heard. Oh that we had more mothers and grandmothers praying like this, teaching the next generation how it's done.

Every day they saturated Ferriday in prayer. They were very faithful. And if somebody knocked on their door, trying to sell something or there to

fix something broken, Aunt Rene and Nannie would ask them flat out, "Do you know Jesus as your Savior?" If they answered no, well, they left the house knowing who Jesus was and that He died for their sins. I wish everybody could have experienced an afternoon prayer meeting with these ladies.

Anyway, Aunt Rene's husband, Arthur, he was not a Christian, and he had no desire to be a Christian. After he got up in age, there was a Saturday morning when my husband said, "I've got to go to Ferriday. I need to speak with Uncle Arthur today." At that time, we were living in my hometown of Wisner, about thirty miles away. I reminded Jimmy of how many times he had gone and spoken to his uncle about the Lord and, while he was very polite about it, their con-

versations always ended with Uncle Arthur saying, "No, I'm not interested in that. "I know you don't I'm fine. No, no, no."

But that Saturday Jimmy was adamant and said, "I just can't help it. I've got to go. I'm going to try just one more time." So we made the

drive to Ferriday, and we went to Aunt Rene's house. Arthur was sitting there in his favorite chair, and we could tell that he wasn't well and hadn't been for some time. My husband pulled up a chair next to him and said, "Uncle Arthur, I purposely came to see you today. I've got to talk to you because I'm not sure that your

heart is right with the Lord. I'm going to ask you not to get mad at me, but we have got to discuss the condition of your soul. If you were to die right now, where would you go? I know you don't want to talk about this, but I've got to know."

Uncle Arthur sat there a moment, staring at my husband. It seemed that's where the conversation was going to end when, just like that, he said, "I'm ready. I'm ready right now for you to talk to me about the Lord." As soon as he said this, the presence of God seemed to fill the room. Jimmy said, "Well, Uncle Arthur, you know what the plan of salvation is, but let's go over it one more time," and he read several verses of Scripture out loud. When Jimmy finished, he said, "Now, I want to pray the sinner's prayer with you."

And Uncle Arthur, his eyes shiny with tears said, "Go ahead. I'm ready. I'm ready right now. Let's pray."

Aunt Rene was standing on the other side of the room, shocked out of her wits because until that moment, Uncle Arthur hadn't allowed anybody to talk to him

about the Lord. Yet there he was, letting my husband lead him through the sinner's prayer. Aunt Rene was weeping and crying, and so were we, thankful to the Lord for what He was doing. For a long time in that small house, we sat there, praising the Lord and worshipping Him. Uncle Arthur, having just given his heart

to Christ, slowly raised up his hands and praised the Lord. It was something to see, really it was.

The presence of the Lord seemed to linger in that room. After a while, Uncle Arthur said, "I'm ready. I'm ready to go now," meaning that he was ready for heaven. And it wasn't too very long after our visit that the Lord took him home.

Looking back, we firmly believe that Uncle Arthur getting saved was a direct result of the Christian example that Aunt Rene demonstrated day in and day out. We also believe that Uncle Arthur was allowed one more opportunity that Saturday morning to hear about God and His plan of salvation-all because of Aunt Rene. Had she not prayed for her husband all those years, he might not have had that opportunity. But the Lord honored her prayers, and it was the most beautiful thing to witness-God's faithfulness to her and His great mercy to him.

I wanted to share this story from our family to encourage all of you who are praying for lost loved ones. Don't give up on them no matter how long it takes or what circumstances you see. God doesn't give up on them, and you shouldn't either. Pray for them just one more time. Go and visit them one more time. God will honor your faithfulness, and you might just get to hear your loved one say, "I'm ready. I'm ready right now." 🚿



Abraham's Separation

PART I THE STUDY OF THE LIFE OF ABRAHAM is actually the study of the doctrine of justification by faith. As well, it is the study of the making of the child of God. Through Abraham's life, we learn how the Lord desires to work in our lives. In this series of articles highlighting the life of Abraham, I pray that you will learn how the Lord works in our lives and what the Lord desires for His children.

The first thing the Lord told Abraham was, "*Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house.*" Let's break this down.

1. *Your country*. The Lord has a specific place for His children to be, and the believer seeks a country, meaning this place, this world, is not our home. Our hearts desire to be in the place God wants us. This world is to hold no allegiance to the believer. We are on a journey—a spiritual journey to the place God has for us. Ur of the Chaldees was not to be Abraham's home, just as Egypt

was not to be home to Moses and the children of Israel. The country we long for is not a place on a map, but it is a person—the Lord Jesus Christ.

- 2. Separate from your kindred. Abraham now belonged to the Lord—not his family, but to the Lord exclusively. As well, we now belong to the Lord, and nothing or no one is to come between us and our relationship with the Lord. In Matthew 4:19, we read, "And He saith unto them, Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men." At His call, these men were to separate themselves from everything that could hold them back from doing God's will. The Lord is calling us to separate ourselves from anyone or anything that will interfere with our relationship with the Lord. We are to love our family and to seek the best for them, but we must not let family come between us and the Lord.
- 3. *From your father's house*. This statement refers to whatever close family members have planned for you. So often, fathers want their children to follow in their footsteps, and sometimes that may also be God's will. However, we must be sure that we seek the Lord for ourselves. The Lord has

a specific plan for your life and a specific place for you. True happiness can only come when we are in the center of God's will.

- 4. Unto a land that I will show *you*. Notice here the Lord said, "Unto a land that I will shew thee." Abraham had no sav in the matter. He was to do what the Lord told him to do. We are to seek the Lord as to what His will is for our lives. Separation from the world to Christ exclusively always brings blessing, as Genesis 12:2 tells us, "And I will make of thee a great nation." Abraham couldn't understand it all, but because of his obedience, the Lord would bring forth from his loins a great nation that would bring to the world the Bible and the Savior. God's plans for us are always bigger than we could ever imagine. We can't see the whole plan of God at one time, but it is revealed to us a little at a time as we obey His command.
- 5. And I will bless you and make your name great. This statement refers to the favor of God upon Abraham's life. When we separate ourselves unto God, He, in turn, will bless us. To bless means "to increase." The Lord would bless Abraham spiritually and

financially. His favor was upon Abraham all because he obeyed the Lord; he separated himself to God for God's pleasure and God's use.

6. *And you shall be a blessing*. Abraham's greatest blessing was the meaning of salvation, which is justification by faith (Gen. 15:6).

Abraham's life truly began when he obeyed God's command for separation. The Lord has a plan for each of us, but in order to receive the plan, we must separate ourselves unto the Lord.

A Study on Christian Character

OUR LORD'S FINAL beatitude strikes a harsh but profoundly factual chord. Unlike its predecessors, which bestow blessings on the merciful, pure in heart, and peacemakers, this beatitude delves into a landscape fraught with adversity and misunderstanding. "*Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake*," it starts, laying the groundwork for an investigation into what it means to live genuinely in the light of divine truth, even when the world and much of religion, opposes it.

This final beatitude has the negative overtones of suffering yet completes the narrative of a Christian's life. It reflects a clear truth—being a Christian entails enjoying blessings while bearing hardship for the sake of righteousness. The road of a Christian, as exemplified by Jesus and His disciples, is not one of continual calm but one littered with the thorns of persecution. Interestingly, this beatitude comes after the appeal to be peacemakers, implying that sincere peacemaking in a world that frequently rejects peace may attract conflict and persecution.

John Stott, a well-known Christian leader, captures this paradox by noting that being hated, rejected, and persecuted is as crucial to a good Christian as purity of heart and mercy. This stark fact serves as a reminder that Christ's followers are not above their Master, for if the world rejected Jesus, it is predictable that it would reject those who try to emulate Him. The apostle Paul underlines this message, claiming that holiness will eventually result in persecution.

WHAT THIS BEATITUDE DOES NOT SAY

However, this beatitude is not a call to pursue suffering for its own purpose. There is a significant distinction

between being persecuted for righteousness and being punished for undesirable or problematic behavior. Many believe that they are being persecuted because of their faith when, in reality, they are not being persecuted at all. Instead, they are simply hard to deal with. Just because you might be unpleasant, difficult, or an actual curmudgeon does not mean that people are persecuting you. We can bring endless suffering upon ourselves and create plenty of difficult circumstances by simply being difficult.

PERSECUTION FOR RIGHTEOUSNESS' SAKE

The essence of this beatitude is in the reason for persecution—it is not for being disagreeable or controversial but for adhering to Jesus Christ's values and love; it is a persecution moti-

vated by a desire to live according to God's righteousness—a life that mimics Christ's. Persecution will come when a believer decides to place his faith in Christ and the cross exclusively, which allows the Holy Spirit

to produce righteousness—or right living—within one's life. To make it plain, people will not like it when you live right, act right, and do right.

History and Scripture show that persecution can come from unexpected areas, even organized religion. Jesus was opposed by scribes and Pharisees; Paul by religious leaders and Judaizers; and individuals seeking a pure faith have frequently been challenged by the very institutions designed to defend it throughout history. This internal battle within religious communities reveals a vital truth: genuine faith often contrasts with formal religious systems that deviate from their fundamental foundations.

AN UNFORTUNATE QUESTION

Let me venture into this realm and ask this question: Can persecution come upon an individual from those who claim to believe the message of the cross? Unfortunately it can, and here's why: When a person claims to understand the message of the cross but only has a head knowledge of this tremendous word, he can lash out at those who do have a proper understanding of the cross of Christ. In other

words, the same religious spirit from organized religion can emanate from those who claim to understand the cross.

How can this be? Pride. When it comes to Christianity, pride is the most destructive force. Those

who have perverted this message to justify condemning those around them have lessened the work of Christ and are misguided in their beliefs. The message of the cross was never intended to be used as a whipping post to look down on and slander others who may not believe as they do, and those who use the message of the cross for this purpose will ultimately answer to the Lord for their actions.

HOW SHOULD WE REACT TO PERSECUTION?

In the face of such adversity, the attitude advised by this beatitude is surprising yet profoundly transformative. Matthew 5:12 says, "Rejoice, and be exceedingly glad." This is not a call to superficial happiness but one of absolute joy based on the assurance of what lies beyond the persecution-the promise of heaven and God's never-ending presence. This delight stems from the understanding that suffering for Christ's cause is a sign of belonging to a separate kingdom that is not of this world. Our lives are not our own, for the Spirit of God controls us, and our loyalty is to our Savior, Jesus Christ. Our home is not this world; we are strangers in a strange land awaiting our ultimate homegoing. So we can rejoice and be exceeding glad because we are suffering for His sake, and soon, all will change.


The ultimate promise of this beatitude is not an immediate recompense but rather an eternal one. In the midst of adversity, Christians are reminded that their actual home is beyond the temporal sphere. They are traveling to a land where there will be no more agony, sadness, or suffering. The journey may be difficult, but the end result is unsurpassed joy and peace. We should constantly think of the end, believing in that which cannot be seen with the natural eye but the eye of faith. We should set our affections on things above, not below (Col. 3:2), and live knowing that we will be with Him for eternity.







Dear Sister Frances, I was born in a Hindu family where my Dad owns and built a big Hindu temple in my county on the same street we live in India, and still it is there, and 2,000 people were fed every year. My dad sacrificed his time and money in that temple, and I was also taking part in deep rituals. I was trying to find God and quite often I used to prophesy, but it was not from God, but turned out to be true. It was a torment. When I moved to London, I still went to temple and followed Hinduism where the spirit visited me there too. But I was touched by the Lord and gave my life to Christ. Ten days after I took baptism in the same month after I accepted Jesus Christ as my personal Savior, my house in India-there was a fire accident and all the idols in my house were burnt, and my parents were so upset, and my mother told me to finish my life. I became homeless and told the Lord that I would follow Him, and today my mum became a prayer warrior in Jesus and even built a separate room for people to come and pray in her place in her house. And my sister who slapped me because I preached Jesus also became a Christian! And finally, my dad, after thirteen long years of praying and believing God, when he visited London the second time, I was always playing Jimmy Swaggart Ministries, so he had no other option except to listen. He started drawing toward it. My child had developed a medical condition when she started taking part in the singing ministry. When my dad started

Is Church Doctrine Important?



INTRODUCTION

I am amazed at how many sincere Christians begin attending a certain church and seem to have no interest in the doctrinal statement or articles of faith embraced by that particular church. I realize that when you first visit a church, you notice if the people there are friendly and gracious. You pay particular attention to the worship and music, etc. You listen carefully to the pastor as he presents his message for that Sunday. But you should take time to read their doctrinal statement or find out what they believe, especially about Calvinism. Paul writes in Ephesians 4:14, "That we henceforth be no more children tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive." Sad to say, there are so many individuals on television, internet, Facebook, and YouTube teaching things that are not sound doctrine. A doctrinal statement

is very important for every local church. Have you studied what your church really believes?

UNDERSTAND WHAT THE WORD DOCTRINE REALLY MEANS

The two Greek words found in the New Testament for doctrine are *didache* and *didaskalia*. The word *doctrine* (didache) is used in the New Testament thirty times and is referring primarily to the authority and act of teaching. In referring to Jesus, Matthew 7:28 says, "The people were astonished at his doctrine." He spoke truth with authority. The other Greek word used in the New Testament is didaskalia, and it means, primarily, "the instruction and the content of one's teaching." It is used twenty-one times in the New Testament, mostly in the epistles. According to Vines Complete Biblical Dictionary, the Greek word used by the Apostle Paul in I Timothy 4:16 and II Timothy 3:16 is didaskalia.

WHAT DID THE APOSTLES WRITE CONCERNING THE IMPORTANCE OF SOUND DOCTRINE?

A study of these nine Scriptures clearly emphasizes the importance of sound doctrine:

- Ephesians 4:14 says that we are not to be influenced by every "wind of doctrine."
- I Timothy 1:3 urged Timothy to allow "*no other doctrine*" to be taught.
- I Timothy 1:10 identifies those who do not teach "*sound doctrine*."
- I Timothy 4:13 begs Timothy to "give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine."
- I Timothy 4:16 reminds Timothy to "take heed unto thyself, and unto the doctrine."
- II Timothy 3:16 says, "All scripture

is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine."

- II Timothy 4:2 instructs Timothy, "Preach the word...with all longsuffering and doctrine."
- Titus 2:7 says, "In all things shewing thyself a pattern of good works: in doctrine."
- II John 1:10 says, "If there come any unto you, and bring not this doctrine, receive him not into your house."

I have heard some preachers denounce others who emphasized doctrine. The apostles clearly taught the need for pastors to set forth sound doctrine. You need to make sure that you are part of a church where correct doctrine is understood, believed, and taught weekly. Paul said in II Timothy 2:15, "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that need not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth."

In respect to doctrines and creeds, have you ever heard of the Apostles' Creed? Many Christian churches cite the Apostles' Creed every Sunday morning as part of their worship experience. According to my studies, there is nothing in historical records that really proves that it came from any of the twelve apostles, but it may have. Yet, it is considered valid, and it is called the Apostles' Creed. Church history records that it was written in the early part of the second century, later referred to by the Bishop of Rome at about AD 341, and later used by Bishop Ambrose of Milan (Italy) at about AD 390.

THE APOSTLES' CREED

Versions of the Apostles' Creed differ very little, but the one I present here is considered traditional or older Roman:

"I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth. And in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord. Who was conceived of the Holy Spirit, Born of the Virgin Mary, Suffered under Pontius Pilate, Was crucified, dead, and buried, Descended into hell [hades], On the third day, rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven. And is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. Whence He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, The holy Catholic [worldwide] Church, The communion of saints. The forgiveness of sins, The resurrection of the body, And life everlasting. Amen."

When you study this ancient creed, which is probably about 1,900 years old, you can see the important doctrines embraced and promoted by the second century church. It should be printed and recited in every church at least once a year. Some congregations recite it every Sunday morning. It could be placed in the Sunday church bulletin monthly. All Christians, children, and youth should know this creed.

WHY DO CREEDS AND DOCTRINAL STATEMENTS MATTER?

Paul wrote, "Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine" (II Tim. 4:2).

I give three reasons why creeds and doctrinal statements matter:

- 1. A creed helps new and old Christians distinguish between what is known as essential doctrine and those doctrines that are not completely necessary for salvation and eternal life.
- 2. Creeds and doctrinal statements assist new Christians as to how to articulate correctly their major beliefs and how their beliefs differ from doctrines taught elsewhere.
- 3. Jesus declared in John 8:32, "*The truth shall make you free*." Sound doctrine facilitates greatly one's Christian growth. Think about the importance of the message of the cross.

In Part II of this article, I will share additional information concerning the Nicene Creed, the Chalcedonian Creed, the Augsburg Confession, and John Wesley's Twenty-five Articles of Religion.

"Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God. But exhort one another daily, while it is called Today; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin." –HEBREWS 3:12-13

An Evil Heart of Unbelief

THE AUTHOR OF HEBREWS warned the readers of this epistle against embracing an evil heart of unbelief. The phrase, "*Take heed, brethren*," implies that all Christians must be careful not to fall into the state of unbelief. An evil heart of unbelief is something that can attach itself to any believer at any time. Christians are warned to not become susceptible to this strategy of the enemy. This warning against unbelief points readers back to the example of Israelites who had been delivered from Egypt but then failed to believe God. They were ultimately denied entrance into the promised land. As Bible students will recall, God sentenced them to perish in the wilderness. They never received the good that God had intended for them. This was and is the result of the sin of unbelief.

WHAT IS UNBELIEF?

Unbelief is a decision not to believe what God has said or revealed. Take note that the term *evil* is the description of how God feels about the heart that refuses to walk forward in what He has revealed. Let's take a moment and consider how the believer receives faith in the first place. According to Romans 10:17, *"Faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God."* Therefore, faith leaves where it was residing and comes to rest in a brand-new location. True faith is always initiated by God. It is not something that can be worked up or achieved by human endeavor. Note that faith comes through the agency of hearing. The idea of hearing cannot simply mean hearing with the physical ear. Instead, it indicates that God has revealed or illuminated some certain truth to the "hearer." The Holy Spirit is taxed with the responsibility of bringing the knowledge of God to the heart of man. When

God reveals truth to a believer through the Spirit, He also grants a measure of faith to the recipient of the truth. The choice to accept and walk in what God has revealed now exists. Christians are fond of saying that when God revealed something to them, "They knew, that they knew, that they knew" it was true. This statement shows that faith has arrived and the ability to believe is now present. It must also be acknowledged that God never forces His will on a human being. That which God has freely given is meant to be united with the choice to believe what God has revealed. If a person chooses to disregard or not walk in that trust, then he has made a choice not to believe what God has given. This choice is spoken of in Scripture as an evil heart of unbelief.

THE HARDENING OF THE HEART

A choice to reject what God has revealed gives room to dire spiritual consequences. There is a spiritual law that states when something is revealed and then rejected, that God hardens the heart and spirit of the disobedient one. The term deceitfulness of sin describes the idea that God's revelation was rejected because it was opposed by some fleshly desire. Satan is an expert at offering alternatives to God's revelations that appear to be desirable. He is an expert at promising something that he will never deliver. That's why it is referred to as deceitful. What is deceitful will never bring the joy, satisfaction, or blessing that it seems to promise. If we follow our own hearts



instead of the revealed will of God, we will find ourselves being spiritually and mentally hardened. Ultimately, we may find ourselves in a wilderness that God never intended for us to encounter.

EXHORT ONE ANOTHER DAILY

It is the function of the body of Christ to exhort and encourage each other to believe the things that God has revealed. This encouragement should come from Christians who understand how God works and will encourage others to walk out revealed truth. An Old Testament illustration of this can be found in II Chronicles 20 when King Jehoshaphat faces multiple enemy armies simultaneously. Due to this imminent threat, He gathers all of Judah together for a time of fasting and prayer. As they seek God, a man named Jahaziel receives a prophetic word. He tells the people not to be dismayed by the great multitude surrounding them, for the battle is not theirs but God's. God speaks again as Jahaziel says, "Ye shall not need to fight in this battle: set yourselves, stand ye still, and see the salvation of the LORD." At that moment—the moment of revelation-it was easy for most of the people to believe what God had revealed. Everyone was there encouraging one another. Even so, the next day, when Israel was about to face the enemy, Jehoshaphat encouraged the people to continue to believe what God had said the day before. He declared, "Believe in the LORD your God, so shall ye be established; believe his prophets, so shall ye prosper." That word of encouragement helped the people to believe what God had revealed and gave Israel a great victory. A failure to believe God would have been a disaster.

CONCLUSION

What has God revealed to you? What truth do you know as a result of the Holy Spirit revealing it to your heart and mind? It is very important that you do not let what God has illuminated to you drop by the wayside. There will come a time when you will need to have that information available in the battles you face. I encourage you, choose to believe what you have already received. Do not spurn God's truth or revelation and thus exhibit an evil heart of unbelief. Be careful to walk in the truth that you know.

The name of the accords was in reference to the supposed common ancestry of the Jews and Arabs, the descendants of Ishmael. In its biblical context, it means an expression of brotherhood. The Abraham Accords consist of a general declaration alongside of bilateral agreements signed between Israel and the United Arab Emirates, Bahrain, and Morocco in the latter half of 2020, and later with Sudan.

Abraham Accords

BACKGROUND

Modern Israel became a nation by a United Nations vote in November 1947. Arab governments categorically refused to extend diplomatic recognition of Israel. Israel declared her independence and nationhood on May 14, 1948, after a tough war against a multi-national Arab-Islamic effort to destroy her. A series of Arab-Israeli wars took place for decades that followed, mostly confined to Israel with its neighbors at its borders. After a humiliating defeat of a confederation of Arab nations in 1967 (Six Day War) to destroy Israel and create a pan-Arab Middle East, a subsequent multi-national Arab surprise attack against Israel also proved to be



a failure in 1973 (Yom Kippur War). Egypt became the first Arab country to conclude a peace treaty with Israel at the 1979 Camp David Accords. In 1993, Israel agreed to a two-state solution with the Palestinian Liberation Organization (PLO). In 1994, the country of Jordan engaged in a peace agreement with Israel. Keep in mind, the idea of a two-state solution began in the late 1930s when Lord Robert Peel of England visited the Middle East and made the recommendation that the best way to secure lasting peace between Jews and Arabs was to create two states living next to each other, although Israel had been promised the land under the Balfour Declaration decades before. Notwithstanding, the Bible clearly teaches the land is God's, and He has chosen Israel to possess the land—the descendants of Isaac and not those of Ishmael.

The two-state solution did not materialize within the intended time frame. In 2002, The Arab League endorsed a Saudi

proposal known as the Arab Peace Initiative for its member states to establish normal relations with Israel in exchange for an independent Palestinian state. The Arab Peace Initiative mandates East Jerusalem as the new capital of a Palestinian State, pre-1967 borders, and the right-of-return for Palestinian refugees. Negotiations between Israel and the Palestinian Authority remained unfruitful. However, mutual interests between the Arab nations and Israel began to develop. The advent of technology and trade, as well as security issues with the common enemy of Iran, ushered in a level of tolerance with one another. The United States sweetened the deal with benefits of entering into the Abraham Accords by rewarding the United Arab Emirates with a deal to sell them fifty F-35 combat jets. The United Arab Emirates indicated that normalization would provide it with increased leverage to intervene on behalf of the Palestinians, but some observers speculated that the deal would encourage the Arab states to set aside the Palestinian cause when it suited those states' interests. In reality, false Western hopes and incentives are not sufficient to persuade religious and traditional Arab-Islamic thinking to fully embrace national Israel with Jews to live in mutual peace with equal rights among those in the Middle East.

Egypt and Jordan have had formal relations with Israel for forty-three years and twenty-nine years, respectively. Furthermore, the PLO and Israel have had a treaty for thirty years, with the Palestinian Authority working in daily coordination with Israel for nearly that entire period. However, during this this time, acts of terrorism have been encouraged and financially rewarded by Palestinian leadership through a pay-for-slay policy. Some Arab parties to the Abraham Accords already had previous existing informal relations with Israel. This means the accords are not peace treaties, as heralded, but merely agreements to bring into the open and formalize relations. This has allowed them to deepen and diversify away from a largely security and intelligence focus that occurred behind the scenes. There is far more symbolism at play here. What the Abraham Accords offer is an added basis for strong relations with the United States-being Israel's closest Arab ally carries weight in Washington-at a time of great concern over the future of America's presence and security architecture in the region. It further helps to develop a regional coalition of states to contain and confront adversaries such as Iran.

Another significant challenge to the Abraham Accords is the regional unpopularity toward normalization with Israel. According to March 2022 polling from the Washington Institute for Near East Policy, 71 percent of Emiratis and 76 percent of Bahrainis oppose the normalization agreements their governments signed with Israel, numbers that could be on the low end given the difficulty of collecting polling data critical

of government policy in these countries. Saudi citizens oppose the Abraham Accords at roughly the same level—75 percent-according to the 2022 survey. That number rises even higher in countries with longstanding peace treaties with Israel, namely Egypt and Jordan, whose citizens oppose at a rate of 84 percent.1 According to the Arab Center's annual Arab Opinion Index which polls fourteen countries in the region, an average of 84 percent oppose diplomatic relations with Israel, with only 8 percent in support.² Strong Palestinian sentiment and support for the Palestinian cause regionally has not been weakened and most feel Israel cannot be trusted in any agreement with the Palestinians. The Arab Opinion Index shows that an average of 76 percent of people across the region believe that "the Palestinian cause concerns all Arabs and not the Palestinian people alone.³

Next month, we'll explore the bilateral agreements' language to see why it could be harmful to Israel in the long run.

In the previous article, we were introduced to Paul's usage of the term en Christos-in Christ. Seventy-five times Paul uses this powerful phrase. We saw that we are redeemed, justified, set free from condemnation, drawn close to God, live in victory, and called saints-all because we are in Christ.

In Christ



THE LAW OF THE SPIRIT IS IN CHRIST

The choice is simple—we either live according to the law of the Spirit, or we die under the domain of the law of sin and death: "For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death" (Romans 8:2).

Being in Christ grants us access to the life found by living according to the law of the Spirit of life. We, therefore, choose to walk in the Spirit and not fulfill the lust of the flesh (Gal. 5:16). Victory over the flesh is found in Christ.

THE CHURCH IS SANCTIFIED IN CHRIST

Addressing the church of Corinth, Paul speaks to the source of their sanctification; "Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints..." (I Cor. 1:2). As residents of one of the most morally debased cities in the Roman Empire, they became righteous by being in Christ. This remains true of every believer regardless of his past. He is sanctified in Christ.

WE ARE NEW CREATURES IN CHRIST

A metamorphosis takes place the nanosecond a person accepts the free gift of salvation. Paul states it this way: "Therefore if any man

be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new" (II Cor. 5:17). "All things" means more than our wicked past. It also means our attempts to become righteous apart from

become righteous apart from Christ. The Bible says, "But what things were gain to me, those I counted loss for Christ. Yea doubtless, and I count all things but loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord: for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them but dung, that I may win Christ" (Phil. 3:7-8).

WE ARE SEATED IN HEAVENLY PLACES IN CHRIST

We were co-crucified, co-buried, and co-risen with Christ. The Bible says, "*And hath raised us up together, and made us*

"'All things' means more than our wicked past." sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus" (Ephesians 2:6). Our condition may go up or down according to the level we walk in the Spirit of life, but our position does not change as long as our faith remains constant in the

completed work of Calvary. We are seated in heavenly places because we are *en Christos*—in Christ.


THE LAW IS COMPLETE IN CHRIST

Paul, considered the most knowledgeable man in reference to the demands of the law, understood that Christ fulfilled the law. Galatians 6:15 says, "For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision, but a new creature." To attempt to fulfill the requirements of the law is an exercise in futility. When Christ said "tetelestai," meaning, "It is finished and paid in full," He spoke it for our benefit. In the Greek it is a perfect tense verb, meaning a past action with ongoing results. The requirements of the law were finished at the cross with the result they remain finished for all who are in Christ.

ARE YOU IN CHRIST?

My hope is that Paul's usage of the term *en Christos* has blessed you and helped you to understand that being in Christ means that we have access to the overcoming life that Christ died on the cross to make available to you. The gospel is simple—believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved. Accept the completed work of Calvary as the full payment of your sins and then walk daily with the focus of your faith on the Christ of the cross and the cross of Christ.

"And Ezra opened the book in the sight of all the people; (for he was above all the people;) and when he opened it, all the people stood up: And Ezra blessed the Lord, the great God. And all the people answered, Amen, Amen, with lifting up their hands: and they bowed their heads, and worshipped the Lord with their faces to the ground." –NEHEMIAH 8:5-6

The Value of Expository Preaching and Listening

HOW VITAL IS PREACHING in the life of the church? What if the listeners do not understand? What if they do but just don't value what is being said? Preaching is not just about the man in the pulpit, but also the parishioner in the pew. Nehemiah 8:5-6 shows the characteristics of authentic Bible exposition. After generations in exile, Israel had a renewed affection for God's Word.

They respected the book of the law of Moses. The people rose in respectful silence when Ezra opened the scroll. The people listened attentively to the Scriptures. They responded in an expression of praise and worship to God saying, "Amen, Amen."

In my own ministry assignments through the years, the adult parishioners were not used to expository messages and, in turn, had not developed a sincere hunger for the Word of God. It was my desire for them to see the value of expository preaching and listening, which fosters application of this type of preaching in changing people's lives.

Since expository preaching begins with the text of Scripture, it is, in itself, an act of worship. Expository preaching forces the pastor to study God's Word more thoroughly and thoughtfully than when applying other preaching styles. Through study, God changes the preacher's heart through this deep engagement with Scripture and then the congregation's heart also. Expository preaching enables the congregation to learn the Bible, but only if they learn to hear it.

Emphasizing and preaching expository messages exposes the congregation to

more of Scripture than a pastor would by self-selecting a topical sermon that may neglect difficult or seemingly obscure texts. Exposition affirms the priority and sufficiency of a passage. The church would be served best when it makes clear that it is committed to teaching the Bible by teaching the Bible. Since expository preaching keeps the pastor from last-minute preparation, it does not leave the congregation wondering what the preacher will talk about on Sunday. Expository preaching can help spur the parishioner on to personal study of a book ahead of time.

The Bible demonstrates that the people of God need to be expository listeners. A thorough exegesis of Nehemiah 8 and 9 will show that congregations who learn to hear Scripture explained are moved to worship. An exegesis of James 2:22, Titus 2:11-14, and Romans 10:9-10 demonstrates that genuine Spirit-enabled obedience comes from faith fostered by hearing God's Word.

AN EXEGESIS OF NEHEMIAH 8-9

To celebrate all that God had done, Nehemiah called the people together for a celebration and dedication service at the public square near the water gate. This was also a sacred time for the Jews—several feasts were held during the seventh month. In the seventh month, the Feast of Trumpets

was held on the first day; the sacrifices for the Day of Atonement were offered on the tenth day, and the Feast of Tabernacles was celebrated on the fifteenth day. This was a time of celebration and dedication, but more importantly, it was a time for worship.

When considering the elements of worship found in Nehemiah 8 that include the assembly of worship and the congregation (verses 1-6), one sees that this was not just a select group of the religious elite. This worship experience involved everyone. The text in verses 1-3 and 5-6 show that all of the people were involved in worship unto the Lord—men, women, and even the children—none were left out or excused; all were present. Each person was in his place, and they were united in their purpose. The people called for Ezra to bring the Word of God.

The focal point of the worship service in Nehemiah 8 was the Word of God. They had been in captivity and did not enjoy the privileges of worship and biblical instruction that they had at Jerusalem. Ezra read the Word of God from morning until midday. They were not concerned with time; they did not want to simply get finished and go home.

The Word presented and preached in worship services affects people's lives. Notice, the Scripture brought respect. When Ezra opened the Word of God, the people stood up; they stood in attention to the Word. They knew the Word of God

> was beneficial for their lives, and there was a respect and eagerness for the Word. The Word was read

and preached and brought rejoicing to the hearts of the people. They lifted their hands and rejoiced in the Lord. The Bible brought comfort to them, and they had reason to rejoice. They had many emotions upon hearing the Word of Godthey bowed their heads and worshipped the Lord with their faces to the ground. The people did not feel worthy to lift their heads. They were in the presence of the Lord, and they feared God and worshipped Him. The people showed commitment as they stood in their place for a large portion of the day reading the Word of God. For another part of the day they confessed and worshipped the Lord. They read the Word for three hours and then confessed and worshipped God for another three hours. They were committed to the worship service. Hearing God's Word sparks a revival.

The hearing of the Word of God must be a priority. Hearing the Word of God is evidence that the Spirit of God is working within the body of believers. However, it is still important to cooperate with that work rather than resist it. The hearers need to cooperate with God's Spirit if the Word of God is going to do its full work in them. A preacher must speak in a clear, easy-to-understand way. The preacher's main goal should be to make the people understand, not to impress or entertain them. The preacher must communicate the sense of the passage of Scripture. The people must leave understanding God's Word better, not understanding the preacher's opinions better. 🚿

But your responsibility is that you do everything you can to help make it possible, which you are doing, and for which we appreciate more than words could ever begin to say.

STANDING BEFORE THE LORD

One day all of us will stand before the Lord to give account of this life and this ministry—to give account of what we are doing, whatever that may be. I know that some of you think, "Brother Swaggart, I live on a little pension, and I can't do much." Yes, you can. Whatever it is that you give, we so much appreciate it, and it is so very important. But you can pray for us, as so many of you do, and hopefully all of you do. To be frank, that means more to me than anything else.

OUR RESPONSIBILITY

Do you realize that obeying the command of the Lord to take the gospel to the entirety of the world is my responsibility, and it's yours as well. In fact, it's the responsibility of every single believer on the face of the earth.

Jesus said, "For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul?" (Matthew 16:26).

So that puts an entirely different complexion on everything. When we consider the worth of a soul, and Jesus saying that that it is worth more than the entire world—that gives us room for pause. 


