



If the believer doesn't understand the cross of Christ as it refers to sanctification, in other words, how we live for the Lord on a daily basis, then the only other alternative is spiritual adultery. And to be sure, even as physical adultery destroys a marriage, likewise, spiritual adultery will destroy the marriage of the believer with the Lord. It cannot be otherwise.

THE WHOLE HEAD IS SICK. AND THE WHOLE HEART FAINT "Why should you be stricken anymore? you will revolt more and more: the whole head is sick, and the whole heart faint. From the sole of the foot even unto the head there is no soundness in it; but wounds, and bruises, and putrifying sores: they have not been closed, neither bound up, neither mollified with ointment. (The statement of verses 5 and 6 not only describes moral character, or rather the lack thereof, but also the severity of future just but unavailing punishment. Israel refused to repent notwithstanding such punishment. The 'head' and 'heart' of Israel respectively represented the intellectual and moral natures. Israel had turned away from God in both her mind and heart. The deadly 'bruises' and 'sores' of Israel, while but a spiritual analogy, still, could not be cured by anything except the Lord)" (Isa. 1:5-6).

If these passages described the condition of the church some thirty years ago, and they most definitely did, then how much worse is the situation now? Spiritual adultery is the problem!

WHAT THE SPIRIT IS SAYING TO THE CHURCHES Regarding the messages of Christ to the seven churches of Asia, which, in fact, typify the church age from the early church unto the present, in every one of these messages He closed it by the admonishment, "He that hath an ear, let him hear what the

Spirit saith unto the churches" (Rev. 2:7, 11, 17, 29; 3:6, 13, 22).

The short phrase, "He that hath an ear," refers to those who truly want what "thus saith the Lord." In other words, they are listening for the voice of the Holy Spirit.

The modern church is now in the Laodicean Age. In other words, the message of our Lord to the church at Laodicea describes the time in which we now live. It is the closing message, meaning that the dispensation of the church is almost over. The following is the message to this church, which, in effect, is the message to the modern church.

Our Lord said: "And unto the Angel (pastor) of the church of the Laodiceans write (this is the 'apostate church'; we do not know when it began, but we do know it has begun; it is the last church addressed by Christ, so that means the rapture will take place very shortly); These things says the Amen, the faithful and true witness (by contrast to His church, which is not faithful and true), the beginning of the Creation of God (Jesus is the Creator of all things)."

LUKEWARM "I know your works, that you are neither cold nor hot (characterizes that which is prevalent at this present time): I would you were cold or hot (half measures won't do). "So then because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot (if a person is lukewarm toward something, it means he hasn't rejected it, but at the same time he has by no means accepted it; in the mind of God, a tepid response is equal to a negative response), I will spue you out of My mouth. (There is no prospect of repentance here on the part of this church, or restoration. In fact, there is divine rejection.)"

HAVE NEED OF NOTHING? "Because you say, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing (they equated the increase

in material goods with spiritual blessings, which they were not); and knowest not that you are wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked (the tragedy lay in the fact that while this church gloated over material wealth, she was unconscious of her spiritual poverty; again indicative of the modern church!)."

GOLD TRIED IN THE FIRE "I counsel you to buy of Me gold tried in the fire, that you may be rich (what they needed to 'buy' could not be purchased with money, but only with the precious blood of Christ, which price has already been paid; but the modern church is not interested!); and white raiment, that you may be clothed, and that the shame of your nakedness do not appear (refers to righteousness which is exclusively of Christ and the cross; this tells us that the Laodicean church is extremely self-righteous; not having the righteousness of Christ, they are 'naked' to the judgment of God); and anoint your eyes with eyesalve, that you may see. (The modern church is also spiritually blind.)"

REPENT "As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten (implies a remnant): be zealous therefore, and repent. (The modern church desperately needs to repent for its rebellion against God's divine order [Christ and the cross] and for following cunningly devised fables [II Pet. 1:16].)"

THE VOICE OF THE LORD "Behold, I stand at the door, and knock (presents Christ outside the church): if any man hear My voice (so much religious racket is going on that it is difficult to 'hear His

voice'), and open the door (Christ is the True Door, which means the church has erected another door). I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with Me. (Having been rejected by the church, our Lord now appeals to individuals, and He is still doing so presently.)"

THE OVERCOMER "To him who overcomes will I grant to sit with Me in My throne (the overcomer will gain the prize

of the throne, which can only be done by one ever making the cross the object of his faith), even as I also overcame, and am sat down with My Father in His throne. (This presents Christ as our substitute, going before us, and doing for us what we could not do for ourselves.) He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says unto the churches. (In plain language, the Holy Spirit is saying, 'Come back to Christ and the cross!')" (Rev. 3:14-22).

WHAT IS THE SPIRIT SAYING TO THE CHURCHES? I firmly believe with all of my heart that the message of the cross of Christ is what the Holy Spirit is saying to this modern church. The modern church has a modicum of understanding respecting the cross of Christ as it regards salvation; however, it has no understanding at all as it regards how the cross of Christ refers to our sanctification, in other words, how we live for God on a daily basis. And yet, 99 percent of the Bible is given over to telling us how to live for God. In fact, 99 percent of everything that Paul wrote in his fourteen epistles, once again, refers to how we live for God. And it was to Paul that the meaning of the new covenant was given.

Most definitely yes, a plethora of information is given regarding salvation, as should be obvious, but almost all of the Bible, which is for believers, is given over to telling us how to live for God.

Considering that, it becomes obvious as to how much the church has drifted off course, when the truth is, the modern church simply doesn't know how to live for God. It cannot know until it properly understands the message of the cross as it regards sanctification. Not understanding this message, it is living in a state of spiritual adultery, which is dragging it even deeper into a morass of sin and shame.

Modern preachers simply do not know how to tell believers to live for God. In fact, the modern church has become so inundated with humanistic psychology that, anymore, it little knows the true Word of God.

Please understand the following: One cannot have both humanistic psychology and the message of the cross. One or the other must go. Either one cancels out the other. Sadly, and regrettably, the modern church has opted for humanistic psychology and, in doing so, it is destroying itself. This is the reason that, in the eyes of God, the modern church is wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked. Spiritual adultery is the problem.

Again, all believers are married to Christ, and we are to look to Him exclusively for all things, whatever they might be. This means that our faith is to be in Christ and the cross and nothing else.

Sometime ago, my husband had a dream, and we believe it was from the Lord. In this dream, he and I were in a big auditorium full of people, perhaps a revival meeting, although the occasion for the gathering was not revealed. For some reason, my husband walked to the back of this auditorium where he saw someone coming out of a hallway, and instantly he knew it was the Lord.

Who Exactly is Satan?

WHAT DID THE Lord look like? My husband couldn't say, but in his dream, the Lord walked from the hallway, passed by him, and then looked back as if to say, "Follow Me," which he did. Together, they went down a different hallway and stopped near a partially opened door that soon opened wider. Inside, my husband saw a man—a very handsome man—looking out and away from things, unaware of anyone around him. My husband turned to the Lord and asked, "That's Satan, isn't it?" The Lord said, "Yes." In the dream, my husband started to weep as he said slowly, almost as a question, "This is the one who has caused me so much trouble." The Lord answered, "Yes," and with that, He closed the door, and the dream ended. The meaning of this dream? My husband doesn't know. But as he relayed the memory of it in a recent service, he said, "I do know this, the Lord never does anything of that nature for it to mean nothing. It always means something. And I thank God today because even though I stood there in that dream weeping as I looked at Satan, by the help and grace of the Lord, He has given me victory over the powers of darkness and over Satan himself."

On Frances & Friends, we take quite a few questions about Satan, so I thought we could address some of them here.

WHO IS SATAN, ANYWAY?

Satan is an angel, albeit fallen. He was created by God along with all the other angels sometime in the distant past. Prior to his fall, the evidence is that he served the Lord in righteousness and holiness for an undetermined period of time.

Satan is real; he's not merely a principal, or a figure of speech. Satan is an actual personal being who heads up his kingdom of darkness. His pride and warped desire to take God's place in the universe introduced sin. He is the cause of all evil, all war, all pain and suffering, all heartache, and all destruction in the world then and now. Sin is the means by which all of this was brought about. As far as we know, Satan is the originator of sin.

WHERE IS HE?

At times, Satan does have access to heaven, even the very throne of God. In Job 2:1, we read, "Satan came also among them to present himself before the Lord." Also in Job, when the Lord asks Satan where he had been (and the Lord knew exactly where he had been), Satan answered, "From going to and fro in the earth, and from walking up and down in it." We also know, from I Peter 5:8, how Satan walks the earth, "as a roaring lion...seeking whom he may devour."

Gabriel tells the story of when he and Jill were in South Africa at a wildlife reserve where only an electric fence separated them from the animals, including lions. He said at one point, the largest lion there roared, probably not the lion's most powerful effort, but still scary enough to send a chill through your bones. In Scripture, Satan is typified by two metaphors—a roaring lion and an angel of light. As a roaring lion, he is very dangerous,

and he persecutes. As an angel of light, he deceives. Satan is to be dreaded more as an angel than as a lion. Your adversary the devil is far more powerful than what the pitiful efforts of man can handle. It takes power to address Satan—far more power than man possesses. It takes the power of God. That power is found in the Holy Spirit, and it is available to every saint of God, but only on the premise of our faith in Christ and what He has done for us at the cross.

WHAT DOES SATAN DO?

Satan accuses. He is ever the accuser of our brethren day and night (Rev. 12:10). Zechariah 3:1 provides an example where we see Satan, standing at the right hand of Joshua, "to resist him." In one sense, Satan has a right to accuse simply because the individual, whoever it might be, is, in fact, guilty (as Joshua is later described with the filthy garments). Consequently, a judicial judgment is rendered by Satan, especially in view of the fact that the evidence is obvious. However, upon faith in the slain Lamb, the price is paid for one's sins, and the judicial judgment that should have been poured out on the sinner is instead poured out on Christ. By virtue of the price being paid and the penalty

being suffered by Christ, which was death, the offending member—as Joshua, as you, as me—is allowed to go free, and Satan is rendered helpless. There is nothing more Satan can say or do.

Satan threatens. He is constantly telling believers terrible things that he is going to do to them. He tells us that he is going to kill us, take our family, steal our health, steal our children, drive us into bankruptcy—any lie that he can get us to believe. But despite all the blow and bluster of the Evil One, you are still here, serving God. If Satan could have done any of the things he threatens, he would have done it a long time ago. He is a liar and the father of it.

Remember, Satan can only do what the Lord allows him to do, and the Lord does allow him certain latitude—not to hurt us, but that our faith might be tested and that we might grow in grace and the knowledge of the Lord.

WHAT DOES HE BELIEVE?

Although the Bible clearly pronounces his doom, Satan is so deceived that he believes he will ultimately be the god of heaven, this world, and the entire universe. It's easy to question whether Satan has read the Bible and learned of his coming fate. But the truth is, he doesn't believe the Bible, even as none of his followers believe the Bible. He is the father of deception and believes his own lie. Despite the fact that he is a created being and greatly inferior to the Creator, who is omnipotent (almighty), omniscient (all-knowing), and omnipresent (everywhere), still, Satan believes he can overcome God.

WHAT IS SATAN'S ULTIMATE END?

The truth is, Satan was made completely ineffective at the cross. There, his power was completely broken, inasmuch as Jesus addressed everything that was lost in the fall. New Testament scholar Dr. Curtis Vaughan says of this verse, "To the casual observer, the cross appears to be only an instrument of death, the symbol of Christ's defeat; Paul sees it as Christ's chariot of victory."

But the ultimate destruction of Satan is recorded in Revelation 20:10, "And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever."







As they ministered to the Lord, and fasted, the Holy Ghost said, Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work whereunto I have called them." –ACTS 13:1-2



Who Is The Holy Spirit?

IT IS ESSENTIAL that every believer have a proper understanding as to who the Holy Spirit is and His role in our lives. As it regards who He is, the text that I have used gives us insight. The Holy Spirit is God, the third member of the Godhead. As well, He is a person, as shown to us in verse two by use of the pronouns "I" and "Me." When one studies the Bible, especially the New Testament, we see the attributes of a person (not a physical person but a spirit being) ascribed to Him. In my text, the Holy Spirit spoke regarding His will for Barnabas and Saul (whether by tongues and interpretation or one of the other vocal gifts). In John14:16, He is called, "Comforter," which, in the Greek, is Parakletos and means "one called alongside of

another to help." So He speaks, and He helps the believer to know and understand the Word of God and helps in our daily living.

John 16:13 tells us the Holy Spirit will guide us, or direct us, and He will show us things to come. He creates, for it was by the power of the Holy Spirit that the universe was created (Gen. 1:2, Job 26:13, Ps. 33:6, Ps. 104:30).

In his book *Knowing the Doctrines* of the Bible, Myer Pearlman quotes Dr. Denio as saying, "The Holy Spirit as deity immanent (abiding) in all creation manifests His presence by what we call the laws of nature. He is the principle of order and life, the organizing power in created nature. All the forces of nature are but evidences of the presence and

operation of the Spirit of God. Mechanical forces, chemical action, organic life in plant and animal, energy connected with nervous action, intelligence, and moral conduct are but tokens of the immanence of God of which the Holy Spirit is the agent."

The Holy Spirit is not only creator of the universe but He is also the creator and sustainer of humanity (Gen. 2:7, Job 33:4). Pearlman says of this, "Man owes his being to the 'two hands of God,' the Word (John 1:1-3) and the Spirit, for it was to these that the words 'Let us make man' were spoken."²

The Holy Spirit can be grieved (Eph. 4:30), meaning "to be sorrowful," or "to offend."

The Holy Spirit "acts." This is shown to us throughout the book of Acts by the many works such as Acts 4:31 and Acts 16:26.

The Holy Spirit convicts (John 16:8), just as a physical person points out one's wrongs, so the Holy Spirit points out sin in our lives.

"The Father creates; the Son redeems; and the Holy Spirit sanctifies; and yet in each operation the Three are present."

The Holy Spirit anoints or empowers (Luke 4:18).

Acts 11:12 states, "And the Spirit bade me go with them, nothing doubting. Moreover these six brethren accompanied me, and we entered into the man's house." As well, in Acts 16:6-7 we read, "Now when they had gone throughout Phrygia and the region of Galatia, and were forbidden of the Holy Ghost to preach the word in Asia, after they were come to Mysia, they assayed to go into Bithynia: but the Spirit

suffered them not."

All that I have written shows us that the Holy Spirit is a person, albeit a Spirit being with a Spirit body.

The Holy Spirit is not only a person but also deity. He is the third person of the Godhead—the Trinity. This does not mean that He is one of three gods, for God is one God (Deut. 6:4), yet He is eternally self-existing in three distinct persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Each is fully God, yet each is an individual person within Himself. All three members of the Trinity are equal in omniscience (knowledge of everything) and have three minds that act as one. They are a unity, or one could say, Trinity!

Pearlman states, "The Divine Unity is a compound unity, and that in this unity there are really three distinct Persons,

and yet is supremely conscious of the other Two Not that there are three Gods, all of whom are independent and self-existing. The three cooperate with one mind and purpose, so that in the truest sense of the word they are 'one.' The Father creates; the Son redeems; and the Holy Spirit sanctifies; and

yet in each operation the Three are present. The Father is pre-eminently Creator; yet the Son and the Spirit are described as co-operating in that work. The Son is preeminently the Redeemer, yet God the Father and the Spirit are described as sending the Son to redeem. The Holy Spirit is the Sanctifier, yet the Father and the Son co-operate in that work."³

In the book, *Systematic Theology*, Kerry D. McRoberts writing on the chapter that deals with the Holy Spirit, says, "Jesus places the three members of the Godhead on the same divine plane in commanding His disciples to go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit"3 (Matt. 28:19).

William Menzies and Stanley Horton in their book, Bible Doctrines: A Pentecostal Perspective, closes out the chapter on the Trinity with this statement, "We worship the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit and recognize their personalities in what we see in the Bible; therefore, we humbly acknowledge that they are one in fellowship, purpose and substance."4

In Part II of this article series, "Who Is the Holy Spirit?" we will deal with the names and symbols of the Holy Spirit.

Let Your Light Shine

IN TODAY'S WORLD, where society is continuously confronted with new difficulties and changes, Christians must see the value of dealing with contemporary issues. As Christians, we are responsible for bringing the light of our faith into all aspects of our lives, including the state of our country. Let's be honest, the world is not just surrounded by darkness; it is darkness. And what's worse is that many of the world's inhabitants love this darkness (John 3:19). Seeing that we are the light of the world, it is incumbent upon us to allow this light to shine before all men and that includes within our communities. That's why it is so critical for pastors to become more vocal about the current concerns facing our country and understand the practical strategies for doing so.

THE ROLE OF CHRISTIANITY WITHIN AMERICA

Since its founding, Christianity has played an essential role in molding the United States of America. The Founding Fathers based the structure of this

nation on Christian ideals and principles, emphasizing virtues such as liberty, justice, and equality. However, the number of people identifying as Christians in America today has declined, and the impact of Christianity in public debate has waned, which endangers the ideals and concepts that serve as the cornerstone of our society. Pastors can contribute to the narrative and offer a Christian perspective by actively participating in discussions on contemporary topics. This can offset secular notions and guarantee that biblical principles are expressed publicly.

Now let's look at three effective ways that pastors can engage:

- 1. Preach on relevant topics. Preaching is one of the most direct methods for pastors to connect with current issues. Pastors can address the concerns of their congregations and provide biblical insight by ministering on relevant themes and incorporating them into their sermons. Pastors can use this strategy to educate themselves and their flocks on what is happening within their communities and across the country and encourage their congregants to live out their faith in the face of societal difficulties.
- 2. Be an effective example of Christ. The mission of every pastor is to provide the light of Christ to the world around them. With so much turmoil plaguing our pulpits today, we need godly men and women who will declare the righteousness of Christ and live it for all to see, both in public and in private. Your light will shine brighter than ever by living a holy life unto God, influencing more people than you can imagine. A small amount of light can significantly impact a darkened environment, and when your light shines before people, they cannot ignore it. Some will revile and persecute,

but others will be captivated by your lifestyle.

3. Collaborate with other churches and organizations. Collaboration is essential for making a more prominent effect, and pastors can make a tremendous impact within their communities by collaborating with other like-minded churches and organizations that share similar values and concerns. This can magnify their voices and address contemporary concerns more effectively by merging their resources, knowledge, and influence.

WE ARE SALT AND LIGHT

As Christ's ambassadors, we are called to be the salt and light of the world. But we need to understand that Christianity is not an "enlightenment," and believers don't become enlightened. The fact is that Christians are light. We walk in light. We live our lives in light—the light of Christ. In the book of Matthew, we read Christ's great Sermon on the Mount, which I believe is the greatest teaching in

existence and probably the most misunderstood and the least obeyed teaching in history. In that sermon, He told the disciples and those listening, "You are the light of the world." We need to start walking in that light and acting as if we are in light because we are the light. We are a reflection of Jesus Christ.

Engaging in current events is crucial for pastors and all Christians. Pastors must play an important role in molding the course of our country by actively participating in conversations, addressing concerns, and providing biblical advice. Let us accept this challenge of engaging in current events and being the voice of hope, truth, and love within our communities and beyond.

Let us follow the example of our Captain, Jesus Christ, who brought spiritual light into this world. Seeing that He is the light, and we are reflectors of this light, let us pray that our Lord places us in positions to allow our light to shine more effectively. As God does the positioning, let us shine wherever we are, for His light in us will significantly impact the darkness surrounding our communities.

The Apostle Paul's **Last Words**

IN MANY CASES, an individual's last words are very important. Many scholars believe that Paul's second epistle to Timothy represent his last words in respect to a divine word given by the Holy Spirit to the church. During his thirty years of ministry, Paul had written thirteen powerful epistles.

In my studies, I have become convinced that the apostle Paul was actually imprisoned twice in Rome. His first imprisonment is written about by Luke in Acts 28:30: "And Paul dwelt two whole years in his own hired house, and received all that came in unto him." Most New Testament scholars believe that Paul was released after these two years at about AD 64 and journeyed to Spain and other places for his last missionary trip. At about AD 66, during his last chapter of ministry, he was arrested and then placed in the Mamertine Prison in Rome. When touring the city of Rome in May of 2008, Donna and I were able to

go into that prison, to kneel and pray. It was a dark, dungy prison cell where Paul lived for some time.


Take note, it was in prison that Paul writes this last epistle. In II Timothy 4:1-4, he charges or commands Timothy and all ministers to "preach the word." The Greek word for preach is kerusso, which means "to herald as a public crier." Yes, to cry aloud. The Greek word here for word is logos. The beloved John, in John 1, declares that Christ is "Logos." We must preach the "Word," and that word is Christ and Him crucified, resurrected, and coming again. In addition, Paul insists that Timothy must be ready to preach at all times, in season, out of season; to reprove and rebuke; and to teach with much patience and correct doctrine. Real preachers are not called to be comedians, politicians, journalists, or entertainers. In II Timothy 4:5, Paul cautions Timothy and all sincere ministers of the Word, to watch out in all

things. This means to stay alert, live right, stay sober, be aware of what is going on in your world and in the church. Then he adds in this section, be prepared to endure afflictions. Paul writes that we should expect affliction and persecutions.

Also in verse five, Paul emphasizes the importance of evangelism. He commands Timothy to "do the work of an evangelist." This requires a pastor to be constantly looking for lost souls, for

broken people. Remember Mary Magdalen, Zacchaeus, Bartimaeus, and the ten lepers.

In II Timothy 4:6-8, Paul pauses in this final chapter by giving to Timothy an up-to-date report on his spiritual status. He highlights three powerful realities:

- 1. Paul reminds Timothy, "the time of my departure is at hand."
- 2. Paul testifies, "I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have

kept the faith." Wow! He fought; he finished; he kept the faith.

3. Paul states that he expects to receive a crown of righteousness for his faithfulness to God and ministry. He adds that others may receive this crown also.

Finally, in II Timothy 4:9-21, the lonely missionary gets very personal. He urges Timothy, who is currently pastoring in Ephesus, to join him in Rome with "diligence." Paul tells Timothy with much

sadness that Demas has "forsaken me having loved this present world," Paul mentions that Crescens has gone to Galatia to minister, Titus has gone to Dalmatia, and he had sent Tychicus to Ephesus. He adds "Only Luke is with me." Then, Paul insists that Timothy must find Mark and bring him to Rome. He says that Mark will be profitable in ministry. In Acts 15:38, Paul had rejected Mark. In II Timothy 4:13, Paul requests that Timothy bring his "cloke," a coat, some books and parchments. In verse 16, he writes, "No man stood with me, but all forsook me." The great old missionary was feeling very alone. He sends greetings to Prisca, Aguila, and the household of Onesiphorus. He sends greetings from Erastus, Pudens, Linus, and Claudia and "all the brethren" who are evidently in Rome. In II Timothy 4:21, he writes again, "Do thy diligence to come before winter." Earlier, in verse six, he wrote that his departure would be soon. He knew he was facing death. He wanted his son Timothy close by. He also wanted Mark to be with him in Rome.

Paul's last words are found in II Timothy 4:22, "The Lord Jesus Christ be with thy spirit. Grace be with you. Amen." At the end of Paul's third missionary journey, before he entered Jerusalem, he was speaking to the elders at Miletus. He testified, "But, none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus to testify the gospel of the grace Of God" (Acts 20:24).

A Cry for Change

THE PASSAGE

King David had sinned by committing adultery with Bathsheba and having her husband, Uriah, murdered. After a period, he was confronted by Nathan the prophet, who not only announced his guilt publicly, but also proclaimed that God had put away his sin and that the death sentence normally carried out for adultery or murder was not to be carried out upon David.

We can be confident of the truth that David repented. In verses one through nine of this psalm, we clearly see David's attitude toward repentance. David took personal responsibility for his actions. But the fact remains that forgiveness of sin is not the same thing as deliverance from sin. Sin resides in and proceeds from the heart of man and unless a person's heart is changed, it is very likely that the same sin or a similar sin will again surface in the one forgiven. David seems to recognize this truth and cries out to God for a heart change. He knows

that forgiveness is just the first step. Change has to occur, or there will just be more of the same.

There are five keywords in verses ten through twelve that reveal the desire of David's soul: create, renew, rely, restore, and uphold. David is a powerful example of new covenant truth in an old covenant believer. If a new covenant believer cries out to God for a heart change and relies upon God to accomplish the task, then He is willing and able to see to it that it is accomplished. Let us take a closer look at David's cry for change.

CREATE IN ME A CLEAN HEART

In order to change the heart of man, a supernatural series of events must take place. Ephesians 2:8-10 spells out a complete overview of new covenant salvation and transformation. Paul says, "For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast. For we are his workmanship, created in

Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them." The new covenant processes of God always involve the two concepts of grace and faith. When faith is expressed in Christ and His redemptive work, the grace of God (carried out by the Holy Spirit) goes to work in the heart and life of the one expressing properly placed faith. As a result, the believer becomes the workmanship of God, created new and consistently changed within the sphere of being in Christ. This workmanship of the Holy Spirit is the only thing that can release the human heart from the grappling vines of the fall and transform that same heart into one that bears the image, the nature, and the character of Christ.

When David cries out for God to create in him, he is not relying upon himself to accomplish the change. He knows that despite his hatred of the sin he has committed, his heart will continue to lead him astray if not changed. David's

cry for change is an expression of faith in God's ability to do what David could never do for himself. Change my heart, O God. Create in me a clean heart. This is the cry of faith dependent upon grace to accomplish an impossible task.

RENEW A RIGHT SPIRIT WITHIN ME

The idea of renewal is explained by the concept of renovation. In the last decade, the renovation of homes seems to have taken hold of the American public. Television is filled with programming that shows construction workers tearing out the old contents of a home and replacing it with an updated version that displays a more effective design, one that is

pleasing to the modern eye. The renovation of a house is a good analogy of the renovation of the human heart and spirit. This change can only be accomplished by grace and faith. The believer trusts in the truth that what Christ has done at Calvary has opened the door for the Holy Spirit to accomplish in him what he cannot do for himself. It is the Holy Spirit who takes out of the individual those things that are outdated, no longer needed—things that no longer fit in the lifestyle of a new covenant believer. He replaces those things with provisions for life and godliness. This transformation will only be accomplished as the Spirit moves upon and changes the believer. God never operates from a

labor-for-reward mentality. He will only renew those whose faith is secured in His Son's redemptive work. A believer who is in Christ is a candidate to receive this renewing process as long as his faith remains centered in Christ and not in himself. Renewing is something that will be carried out over time. The role of the believer is to maintain consistent faith in Christ while the role of the Holy Spirit is to accomplish the task of renewing the heart and spirit of the believer. The Bible teaches us that renewal is never a onetime event but an ongoing process. II Corinthians 4:16 says, "For which cause we faint not; but though our outward man perish, yet the inward man is renewed day by day."



This process can only be carried out by grace and faith. Faith must ever be centered in Christ and what He has done for us on the cross. One aspect of God's grace is the internal working of the Holy Spirit in the heart and mind and soul of the believer who is exhibiting proper faith. This cannot be accomplished by any effort of the flesh. As one Bible teacher has well said, "All hope of the flesh has to die." We will cover the final three keywords in the next issue of The Evangelist. 🏕

COMMUNISM IS A RELIGION — The traditional Christian values that formed American culture are irreconcilable with communism.



Cultural Revolution

SATAN'S PRIMARY WORK is to affect the minds of mankind to reject God. The devil occupies the thoughts of man causing him to rebel against God. Satan consumes and distracts society's senses with every form of debauchery. The outcome of this direction is how the devil leads man toward his own destruction. There's no better place to advance his rebellion than to appeal to man's sinful state with its lustful desires rooted in man's pride. God supplied a means for society to live and be reconciled to God. God supplied his righteous laws to reveal His holiness to sinful man. After Adam's fall, all of humanity was born dead in trespasses and sin and therefore needed a Redeemer. God would accept only one sacrifice for the wages of man's sins—a perfect sacrificial death. Because of sin, all born after Adam would not qualify as a perfect sacrifice. Instead, God would send His own Son to pay the penalty for sin, that by Jesus Christ's death on the cross, God would accept our faith in Christ's efficacious sacrifice as the means of receiving His salvation grace.

Contrary to God, Satan has a plan to build a society for man that has its own set of ungodly principles. To accomplish this, he must take control of every facet of society and corrupt the ways of God by his subtlety. Communism is a program of creating a paradise on earth to promote an atheistic conception of social progress. It emphasizes materialism to undermine the spiritual pursuits of mankind to enable communist ideology to spread to every sphere of society. Communism tries to separate morality from law, then destroy morality by concocting malicious new laws and subjecting existing law to distorted and twisted interpretations. Psalm 94 says, "Shall the throne of iniquity have

fellowship with thee, which frameth mischief by a law? They gather themselves together against the soul of the righteous, and condemn the innocent blood." Communism is like cancer—when it spreads, it destroys that which is good. As it metastasizes throughout society, it eliminates national sovereignty and identity, moral and cultural traditions. Psalm 11:3 says, "If the foundations be destroyed, what can the righteous do?"

KARL MARX In *The Communist Manifesto*, Marx proclaimed, "The Communist revolution is the most radical rupture with traditional property relations; no wonder that its development involved the most radical rupture with traditional ideas."1

In addition to his best-known work, The Communist Manifesto, Marx also wrote Das Kapital. These works form the theoretical basis of the communist movement. Early in his life, Marx had been a devout Christian until he turned his soul over to the devil. Prior to his demonic transition, he was an enthusiastic believer in God. In one of his early poems, "Invocation of One in Despair," Marx wrote of his intent to take his revenge on God:

So a god snatched from me my all *In the curse and rack of Destiny.* All his worlds are gone beyond recall! Nothing but revenge is left to me!

On myself revenge I'll proudly wreak, On that being, that enthroned Lord, Make my strength a patchwork of what's weak, Leave my better self without reward!

I shall build my throne high overhead, Cold, tremendous shall its summit be. For its bulwark—superstitious dread, For its Marshall—blackest agony.2

It's essential to understand what motivated Marx and his ideology of communism. One cannot ignore his influence on society, especially to those he appealed to in the realm of philosophy and education. To us who know Jesus Christ, Marx's demonic writings bare witness that it was either Satan himself or demon powers that inspired him.

In a letter to his father, Marx described the changes he was experiencing: "A curtain was fallen, my holiest of holies was ripped apart, and new gods had to be set in their place." Following his signature on the letter, he wrote "A true unrest has taken mastery of me and I will not be able to calm the excited spirits until I am in your dear presence."

Marx also wrote of a young woman who abandons her love of Christ and meets a ghastly end:

Thus Heaven I've forfeited, I know it full well. My soul, once true to God, Is chosen for Hell.3

His changes did not go unnoticed. His father responded to Marx in letters, warning his son that his earthly well-being was not the only desire of his heart. Through Marx's poems, it becomes clear that his intentions were to depart from God and serve Satan. He would go so far as to say that he wanted to take vengeance on the one who rules above. He would expand his rebellious spirit by blaming God as the keynote to perverting civilization that must now be destroyed. Make no mis-

and, ultimately, to destroy man.

KARL MARX

MARX'S INFLUENCE Almost like wildfire Marxist ideology has spread throughout the world. The cab ride to the train of communism is socialism. Where you see socialism begin, you will find communism as its destination. The very concept of progressivism must be understood as nothing more than socialism packaged by educated propagandists to deceive. An example of this is clearly seen in the book that became the Bible of the counterculture in 1959, Eros and Civilization, written by Herbert Marcuse. Marcuse would drastically change American education and culture. Marcuse studied under Martin Heidegger, who was one of the most important philosophers of the Leftist proto-postmodernist thinkers. Postmodernists basically claim to reject any grand narratives, including Christianity. Postmodernism relies on concrete experience over abstract principles, to which Christianity does not assay. Marcuse would use his persuasion as an intellectual to have his students focus on materialism through self-pleasure. He would persistently blame capitalism for crushing man's capacity for critical thought and oppositional behavior. As an advocate for free love, sexual perversion, oppositional behavior, and reactionary thought, Marcuse became the intellectual father of the New Left.

When the Students for a Democratic Society (SDS)—a socialist, Left-thinking radical group growing on college campuses throughout the 1960s—began disrupting campuses and rioting in 1968, Marcuse was one of the few academics that supported their actions. The major thing that Marcuse supplied to the Left was intellectual legitimacy. The New Left began to be seen by the media and the nation as a serious intellectual people. Through gradualism, its adherents became imbedded in all the structures of society. Schools now indoctrinate students with ideology that promotes narcissism and selfishness to the extent that the more bizarre things become, the more the Left says it is the normal that society needs. Yes, it is simply communism fulfilling its outcome—make the people useful idiots to fulfill Satan's plan to destroy man. **

SELF In my previous article, we looked at Satan, the chief enemy of our souls. Now we will look at the role of self on the battlefield. Self is the very essence of who we are and distinguishes us from all others. My "self" is different than your "self." We may have certain things in common, but we are different people. In the Scriptures, self often represents our old life. It is our life prior to placing our faith in the completed work of Calvary.

Knowing Your Enemy



PAUL SAYS, "I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me" (Gal. 2:20). A new life supernaturally emerges as we now live by the faith of the Son of God. We are no longer living under the control of the old self.

SELFISM OR HEDONISM

When I use the term *selfism* or *hedonism*, I am referring to a devotion to self. It is a preoccupation with fulfilling the desires of self, often at the detriment of one's relationship with God. The concerns of self become more important than the concerns of others. When self sits on the throne of one's heart, God is forced to take a back seat.

HEDONISM

The term hedonism comes from the Greek word used for "pleasure." As a theory, hedonism maintains that the highest good in life is the securing of pleasure and the avoidance of pain. Hedonism doesn't ask, "Is it right?" but "Will it bring me pleasure?" In the extreme, it seeks to remove all inhibitions. Self must be pleased. Seeing that repression is considered unhealthy, temptation should not be resisted.

PLEASING SELF IS NOT A NEW CONCEPT

Although prevalent today, a preoccupation with pleasing "self" is certainly not a new concept. It goes all the way back to the garden of Eden when Adam and Eve surrendered to the lust of the eyes,

the pride of life, and the lust of the flesh. By placing their selfish desires above God's command, sin entered the world.

THE SIN NATURE AND THE BELIEVER

At the moment Adam and Eve rebelled against God, God-consciousness was replaced with sin-consciousness. Pleasing self became more important than pleasing God. Whereas, prior to accepting Christ as our Savior, we had no power to resist the sin nature. As believers, the sin nature is not to have dominion over us (Rom. 6:14). Brother Swaggart commented on this verse, "The

sin nature will not have dominion over us if we, as believers, continue to exercise faith in the cross of Christ: otherwise, the sin nature most definitely will have dominion over the believer...the grace of God flows to the believer on an unending basis only as long as the believer exercises faith in Christ and what He did at the cross." So we see, if we are to be victorious over sin, then the focus of our faith must remain on the completed work of Calvary.

DENYING SELF


Denying self is an ongoing principle

in an overcomer's life. Matthew 16:24 states, "Then said Jesus unto his disciples, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me." Brother Swaggart helps us to understand the importance of this verse: "If Christ is not followed by the means of the cross, He cannot be followed at all." Makes one wonder how many Christians are attempting to follow a crossless Christ. Who then are they following if they refuse to be associated with the cross of Christ? By denying self and looking to the completed work of Calvary, the enemy is defeated.

As a young Bible college student, I can remember sitting in chapels and hearing the stories of great missionaries doing awesome works for the kingdom of God throughout the world. The president of my alma mater was a retired missionary and instilled in all of us a love for missions both at home and abroad.



JIMMY SWAGGART BIBLE COLLEGE

A Great Commission Bible College

I WRESTLED WITH the call that God had on my life. Was He calling me to foreign missions? Were the stories that were told meant to unlock my compassion for God's people around the world? Eventually, God's plan for my life began to unfold in a way that His will for me would involve serving as a pastor of a local church. God revealed to me that the local community was my mission field, and I was to partner financially and in prayer with those who were working in missions abroad. God was revealing to me, as a young minister, that all of us are to play our part in fulfilling the Great Commission.

It is important to note what it means for all of us to fulfill the Great Commission. The Great Commission is the instruction of Jesus to His disciples to spread the gospel to all the nations of the world. The Great Commission is outlined in Matthew 28:16-20 where, on a mountain in Galilee, Jesus calls on Christians to go into all the world and make disciples of and baptize all nations in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit: "Then the eleven disciples went away into Galilee, into a mountain where Jesus had appointed them. And when they saw him, they worshipped him: but some doubted. And Jesus

came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world. Amen."

In the fall of 1984, Evangelist Jimmy Swaggart and Dr. Don Paul Gray opened the doors to Jimmy Swaggart Bible College. The college was founded upon the idea of equipping men and women to fulfill the Great Commission in their world. According to the JSBC website: "The founding of a Bible college to prepare men and women for an in-depth, Spirit-filled ministry was the dream of Evangelist Jimmy Swaggart for a number of years. He felt such an institution would play an important role in evangelizing the world as the coming of Christ draws near. As a result of this vision, JSBC opened in the fall of 1984. The goal of JSBC is to build students into the kind of men and women God wants them to be. From its doors, JSBC is sending out missionaries, evangelists, pastors, teachers and leaders to all the world."1

At Jimmy Swaggart Bible College, we believe that every Christian is called to ministry. God certainly calls and equips individuals to vocational ministry as pastors, evangelists, missionaries, etc. But everyone, whether you are a schoolteacher, businessperson, or a stay-at-home mom, is called to do his or her part to fulfill the Great Commission. During the Protestant Reformation, Martin Luther began to emphasize what became known as "The Priesthood of all Believers." Luther stated, "Since he is a priest and we are his brethren, all Christians have the power and must fulfill the commandment to preach and to come before God with our intercessions for one another and to sacrifice ourselves to God."2

This doctrine of the priesthood of all believers states that everyone in Christ shares in His priestly status so there is no longer a special class of people who control the knowledge and forgiveness of Christ to the rest of humanity, and all Christians have the authority to read, interpret, and apply Scripture. This

is one of the foundational doctrines that defined Protestantism. In contrast to the beliefs of the medieval church, the Protestant doctrine of the priesthood of all believers holds that there is no longer a priestly class of people within God's people, but that all believers share in Christ's priestly status by virtue of their union with Christ. Although there was a select group of priests in the Old Testament who mediated the knowledge, presence, and forgiveness of God to the rest of Israel, Christ has come and fulfilled the priestly role through His life, death, and resurrection. Therefore, Christ was the final priestly mediator between God and His people, and Christians share in that role through Him.3

The alumni of Jimmy Swaggart Bible College are a testimony to the commitment of training ministers in every walk of life. JSBC/WEBC alums serve not only as pastors, evangelists, and missionaries, but also as teachers, journalists, businesspeople, medical professionals, and so on. The evangelistic thrust of the college that was instilled many years ago by Brother Swaggart is still at the forefront of what we do today. Every student at Jimmy Swaggart Bible College is thoroughly instructed by capable professors in the message of the cross, biblical hermeneutics, Pentecostal theology, and practical Christian living.

Brother Swaggart has made the statement many times that we are living "in the last of the last days," meaning that the return of Jesus is very imminent. We have a mandate to equip men and women of all ages with the tools they need to reach their world with the gospel. FRANCES AND I have been very happily married seventy-one years this month. When the Lord brought us together—and we were both just kids then—it was truly a great favor that He did for me, and for that I will thank Him forever. When Frances and I were first married, and I was just beginning to preach the gospel, the Lord, in those formative years, gave me a job working with a plumbing contractor. A short time later, we went into full-time evangelistic work. That was some sixty-eight years ago, and for everything that we've been able to accomplish for the Lord, we give Him all the praise and glory.

Whenever the Lord was helping me to put this together, I never dreamed He would use it as He has. But He has made it the Bible of the twenty-first century. In other words, it's the Bible that helps one understand the Bible. It's a tremendous tool for world evangelism.

He has given me a touch of the Holy

Spirit, to help me pray the sinner's prayer with those who are under conviction, and that includes untold numbers. This is not something I thought up in my mind, but it's that which is given to me by the Holy Spirit. And I would ask every one of you who know the Lord, that every time you hear me pray the sinner's prayer, you would pray for us, and pray that God will move greatly upon hearts and lives.

stated this, but it is so important, please allow me to say it again—you are not a part of this ministry by your own choice. You are a part of it because God has called you to be here. What He has called you to do is the same as what He has called me to do. He hasn't called you in a sense to do what we are doing,




